

- 1. Obtain a copy of the current Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations or obtain access to an electronic version, which the PUC has adopted, and become familiar with 49 CFR Parts 382, 390-396, as they apply to your operation.
- 2. Conduct periodic internal reviews of your driver qualification, hours of service control, maintenance, accident records, drug and alcohol testing, and other safety systems to ensure continued compliance with the FMCSR.
- 3. Maintain an accident register for three years after an accident occurs, containing the information required by Title 52 31.11; 49 CFR 390.15(b).
- 4. Ensure that each driver has received educational materials that explain the requirements of 49 CFR Part 382, as well as the carrier's policies to meet the requirements of 49 CFR Part 382
- 5. Ensure supervisory certification according to 49 CFR Part 382. (signed receipt)
- 6. Establish an alcohol and controlled substance testing program which meets the requirements of 49 CFR Part 382.
- 7. Maintain all alcohol and controlled substance testing records required by 49 CFR §§382.401 and 382.403.
- 8. Establish a system to ensure driver's operator's licenses remain current. (49 CFR §391.11)
- 9. Establish a system to ensure medical certificates remain current.
 - a. Verify doctor's knowledge to complete medicals. (49 CFR §391.45)
- 10. Establish complete driver qualification files to include:
 - a. proper employment application (49 CFR §391.21)
 - b. inquiry to state licensing agencies (49 CFR §391.23(a))
 - c. road test (49 CFR §391.31) road test certificate (49 CFR §391.31) or equivalent (49 CFR §391.33)
 - d. annual violation list (49 CFR §391.27) annual review (49 CFR §391.25) note of annual review (49 CFR §391.25)
 - e. medical certificate (49 CFR §391.45)
 - f. documents required for casual drivers (49 CFR §391.63) document required for trip leased driver (49 CFR §391.65)
 - g. retain driver files in accordance with 49 CFR §391.51(c)
- 11. Establish an inquiry to past employers (49 CFR §391.23(c)).
- 12. Ensure all vehicles are systematically inspected, maintained and repaired.(49 CFR §396.3)
- 13.(a). Establish a complete file for each vehicle, recording all inspection, maintenance and repair operations performed (49 CFR §396.3).
 - (b). Retain maintenance records in accordance with 49 CFR §396.3(c).
- 14. Keep all driver vehicle inspection reports signed, certified and reviewed as required on file for at least 90 days. (49 CFR §396.11).
- 15. Require all drivers to prepare accurate records of duty status or time records for each day (49 CFR §395.8a).
- 16. Maintain all duty status records on file, with all supporting documents, for at least 6 months (49 CFR §395.8k).
- 17 (a). Establish a system to control driver's hours of service. Do not allow drivers to exceed maximum hours as found in 49 CFR §§395.3 (property) or 395.5 (passenger).
 - (b). Include hours for secondary employment.
 - (c). Include all on-duty time.
- 18. Develop written policies concerning: prohibited use of alcohol and drugs (49 CFR §382.601)
 the transportation of passengers (49 CFR §392.60)
 controlling speed of vehicle.(49 CFR §392.6)
- 19. Ensure units are marked as required.
- 20. Ensure compliance with Household Goods requirements.
