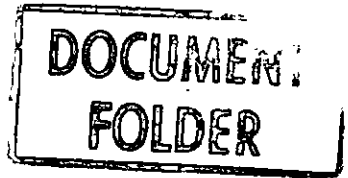

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

BY THE COMMISSION:

This Commission, as the duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, empowered to regulate public utilities within this Commonwealth, represents as follows:

1. That Wonderview Water, Inc., respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 560 Montour Boulevard, Bloomsburg, PA 17815.
2. Respondent holds a Certificate of Public Convenience, issued by this Commission at Application Docket No. A-098489 pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §§1101-1104, authorizing it to provide water service.
3. Respondent is required by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §504, the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§57.47, 59.48, 63.36, and the August 14, 1980 Commission Order regarding "Filing Annual Financial Reports" to file an Annual Report with the Commission no later than March 31 of the succeeding calendar year unless an extension of time for filing has been granted by the Commission.
4. As of the date of this order, respondent has not submitted its Annual Report for the year(s) 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986.
5. By failing to submit its Annual Report(s), respondent is in violation of Commission regulations and orders; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent show cause why it should not be fined or penalized for failure to file its Annual Report for the year(s) 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986 in a timely manner.
2. That respondent has twenty (20) days from the date on which this order is served to file with the Secretary of the Pennsylvania

Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17120, an answer, in writing, under oath, which, as required by the Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code §5.64, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this order.

3. That in lieu of an answer to this order, respondent may file its Annual Report for the year(s) 1985 and 1986 within the time specified for filing an answer to this order. If the respondent so files its Annual Report(s), the time for filing will be extended to the date upon which an answer is due, thereby avoiding any fine or penalty and this order will be discharged without further proceedings.

4. That if respondent fails to file an answer or other responsive pleading, and if respondent does not file its Annual Report for the year(s) 1985 and 1986 within twenty (20) days, respondent will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this order, in accordance with the Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code §5.64. In that event, this Commission may, without hearing, enter an appropriate order which imposes a fine not to exceed fifty (50) dollars for each day any Annual Report is overdue.

5. That if respondent files an answer which admits the allegations contained in this order, and does not file its Annual Report for the year(s) 1985 and 1986, this Commission will enter an order which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or forfeiture as authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq.

6. That if the respondent files a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this order, or which raises material questions of law or fact, and does not file its Annual Report for the year(s) 1985 and 1986, this matter shall be referred to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, the respondent is found to have committed any of the violations alleged in this order, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq.
