(b) Petition of Christopher Zettlemoyer, Esquire for and on behalf of George Hutt, Inc. at A-00085274, to amend Released Valuation Docket No. 56 issued pursuant to 66 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Chapter 23, Section 2304(a) and 52 Pa. Code, Section 23.101 et. seq. to establish and maintain rates for transportation of property that are related to the released valuations declared in writing by the shippers on respective bills of lading. Carrier avers that the released value rates approved in R.V.D. 56 have become antiquated and must be increased to make carrier's Pennsylvania tariff consistent with its I.C.C. and New York State tariffs.

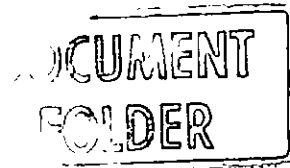

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

George Hutt, Inc., authorized in part, to transport livestock, chiefly valuable for riding, racing, breeding and exhibition or show purposes between points in Pennsylvania as more specifically described at A-00085274, has presented a petition for authority to amend Released Valuation Docket No. 56 issued under date of November 6, 1963, pursuant to 66 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Chapter 23, Section 2304(a) and 52 Pa. Code, Section 23.101 et. seq. to establish and maintain rates for transportation of property that are related to the released valuations declared in writing by the shippers on respective bills of lading. Carrier avers that the released value rates approved in R.V.D. No. 56 have become antiquated and must be increased to make carrier's Pennsylvania tariff consistent with its I.C.C. and New York State tariffs.

The petition having been considered and good cause therein appearing;
THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That subject to the conditions specified in the succeeding paragraphs hereafter, George Hutt, Inc. be, and is hereby authorized to amend Released Valuation Rate Docket No. 56 of November 6, 1963, by filing and posting in the manner required by the Commission's Regulations, released value rates applicable on the transportation of property as described at A-00085274 and published in carrier's Tariff Freight - PA PUC No. 4, amendments

thereto or successive issues thereof, dependent upon the value declared in writing by the shipper or agreed upon in writing, as the released value of the property as follows:

CARRIER LIABILITY
DECLARATION OF VALUE

George Hutt, Inc.'s liability for the loss, damage or non-delivery of a shipment shall be limited to the actual value of the shipment or the declared value of the shipment. The declared value must appear on the bill of lading or other delivery document. The rates and charges named in the tariff are dependent upon the value declared in writing by the shipper and agreed upon in writing as the released value of property on the bill of lading or other delivery document. The shipper shall state the value on the bill of lading, but if shipper fails to state a value, the shipment will not be accepted.

RELEASED VALUATION

RATE BASIS

COMMODITY: Horses other than ordinary, chiefly valuable for riding, racing, breeding or show purposes.

Released to a Value not exceeding
\$1,000.00 per animal

Base Transportation Rate

Released to a Value exceeding
\$1,000.00 per animal

Base Rate with a value charge of Fifty Cents (\$.50) for each \$100.00 or fraction thereof of excess value per animal for each 100 miles or fraction thereof of distance from points of origin to destination as determined in accordance with tariff provisions. (Subject to a minimum charge of \$100.00 per animal).

2. The Commission does not approve hereby the lawfulness, except under 66 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, Chapter 23, Section 2304(a), of any rates or charges that may be filed under the authority of this order.

3. That changes may be made in any commodity rate established under authority of this order, but the commodity description may not be broadened to embrace other articles, nor may any change be made in the released value upon which the rates depend without specific authority of this Commission.

4. That George Hutt, Inc. file its Tariff Freight PA PUC No. 5 containing the provisions of Released Valuation Rate Docket No. 56 as hereby modified and amended on one day's notice, under authority of Pa. Code, Title 52, Section 23.41.

5. That tariffs containing charges established under authority of this order shall show in connection therewith the following notation:

Charges herein based upon released value have been authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at its original Released Valuation Rate Docket No. 56 of November 6, 1963, and by the authorization of Amendment No. 1 thereto, under date of March 14, 1991, subject to suspension or investigation upon complaint.
