Enclosed herewith is a copy of 3rd Revised Page 15 cancelling 2nd Revised Page 15 to Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 54, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent, for its member under power of attorney, and sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law.


3rd Revised Page 15 to Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C.No. 54 provides for an increase in hourly rates from \$92.00 for a van, driver and two (2) helpers to \$104.00 for a van, driver and two (2) helpers.per hour.

Also attached is a copy of applicant's Assessment Report reflecting total household goods revenues for calendar year 2011 of \$450,707. This category is the only area in which the Pa. P.U.C. regulates rates. Consequently, it has been accepted to only apply the household goods category to determine whether the threshold of less than \$500,000 of Pa. revenue qualified.

Lastly, attached is an affidavit of applicant indicating its Pa. revenues was less than \$500,000 and its operating ratio was not less than 93%.

The proposed loose-leaf revision to Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 54 issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent has been filed on sixty (60) day's advance notice.



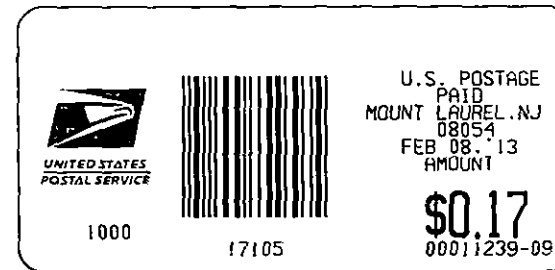
