Pursuant to your letter of April 9, 1985, I have enclosed a Sales Agreement which I have been advised is required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in connection with the application of Mooney's Relocation Specialists, Inc. for the transfer of common carrier rights held by Michael A. DeSteffano, Jr., t/a Mooney's Moving. I have been advised that this Sales Agreement is required despite the fact that this is simply a transfer from a sole proprietorship to a corporation formed by the individual who operated as a sole proprietorship.

Accordingly, I would therefore authorize the amendment of the application, in particular paragraph 14, to provide that the total amount of the consideration to be paid is One Dollar. I have enclosed additional copies of the application previously submitted with the amendment for your consideration.

The transfer is of all of the rights described in the Docket No. A. 00101681, Folder 2, issued to Michael A. DeSteffano, Jr. t/a Mooney's Moving. No Application Will Be Accepted From a Minor

1. A separate application must be filed for each type of service, such as common carrier of persons on schedule; contract carrier of persons; transportation of persons on call or demand; transportation of persons in group and party service; common carrier of property; contract carrier of property.
2. In Paragraph 5, state the number or numbers of any Public Service Commission, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, or Interstate Commerce Commission Certificate or Contract Carrier Permit now held by the applicant.
3. The balance sheet referred to in Paragraph 9 should be as of the latest date available and the Income Statement should be for the twelve months ending with the date of the balance sheet.
4. In Paragraph 11, describe service as authorized under the certificates or permits to be transferred, which the applicant proposes to render. If any part of the service is to be omitted, give reasons for such omission.

SALES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 7th day of June , 1985 between Michael A. DeSteffano, Jr. t/a Mooney's Moving, hereinafter referred to as Transferor, of 2262 Mt. Carmel Avenue, Glenside, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania 19038, and Mooney's Relocation Specialists, Inc., hereinafter referred to as Transferee, of 2262 Mt. Carmel Avenue, Glenside, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania 19038:

1. Transferor holds Pennsylvania interstate motor carrying operating rights issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at Docket No. A 00101681, Folder No. 2. A copy of said authority is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and made an integral part hereof.

2. Transferor agrees to sell and Transferee agrees to purchase all of the rights as set forth on Exhibit "A".

3. The purchase price for said operating rights shall be One Dollar payable in cash at the time of consummation of this transaction which requires prior approval of the Commission. Transferor fully understands and agrees that the requisite approval by the Commission shall be unqualified and the operating rights to be transferred shall be no less than those set forth in Exhibit "A". Otherwise, this Agreement shall immediately become null, void and of no effect.

4. Transferor warrants that said operating authority shall be free and clear of all liens, encumbrances, claims and adversary

attacks of any nature whatsoever at the time of consummation.

5. Transferee agrees to file promptly and prosecute with reasonable diligence, an application with the Commission for approval of this transaction.. Transferor agrees to furnish all information, data and documents deemed necessary by Transferee or required by the Commission and to cooperate in processing said application.

6. Consummation shall take place within sixty days after receipt of an administratively final order of the Commission approving the transaction in toto.

7. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their personal representatives, successors and assigns.


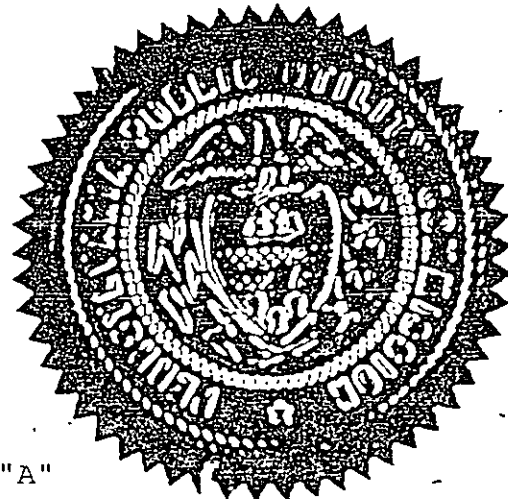

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application docketed December 2, 1983, Michael A. DeSteffano, t/a Mooney's Moving, seeks approval of the transfer to him of all the rights granted to Mooney's Moving & Storage, Inc., a corporation of the State of Delaware, under the certificate issued at A-00034278.

We find the applicant to be fit to hold a certificate of public convenience and that approval of the application is necessary and proper for the continuation of service to the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for the transfer of rights held by Mooney's Moving & Storage, Inc., at A-00034278 be approved and that a certificate be issued to the applicant granting the following rights:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods, personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the furnishings, equipment or supplies of such dwelling, as an incidental part of a removal by the householder from one domicile to another; furniture, fixtures, equipment and the property of stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments when a part of the stock, equipment or supply of such stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, in connection with a removal from one location to another; and articles

including objects of art, displays and exhibits which because of their unusual nature or value require specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods, between points in the village of Glenside, Montgomery County, and within twenty (20) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said village and from points in the said village and territory to other points in Pennsylvania within an airline distance of one hundred (100) miles of the Philadelphia City Hall;

subject to the following conditions:

1. That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the property and rights to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.
2. That the accounts of the transferee shall reflect the same book values as the records of the transferor at the effective date of the transfer, any previously recorded appreciation having been deleted therefrom; provided that the applicant shall not record in his utility accounts any amounts representing the rights herein granted in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.
3. That the operating authority granted herein, or subsequently granted to the applicant to the extent that it is duplicative shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
4. That the certificate holder shall comply with all of the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Pa. Code Title 52, Chapter 31, as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the certificate.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until he has complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of evidence of insurance and a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That issuance of the certificate be withheld pending submission of transferor's Annual Report for the year 1983.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with this order, the rights granted the transferor, Mooney's Moving & Storage, Inc., a corporation of the State of Delaware at A-00034278 be cancelled and the record be marked closed.

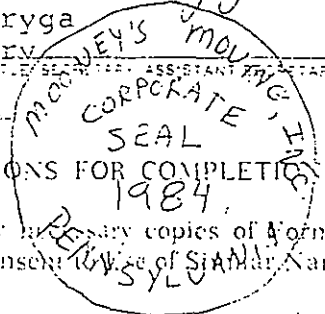
