On April 15, 2004, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation filed an uncontested application for transfer by sale of certain electric facilities or equipment to Johnson & Johnson Merck Corporation in the amount of \$23,650.00. This application was filed pursuant to §1102 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. §1102.
