Dear Mr. Russell:


On June 30, 2005, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation filed an uncontested application for transfer by sale of certain electric facilities or equipment to the Pennsylvania Department of General Services in the amount of \$134,000. This application was filed pursuant to §1102 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §1102.

The application appears to be reasonable and consistent with the public interest, and the application is hereby approved. However, approval of the application does not preclude the Commission from investigating, during any formal proceeding, the reasonableness of this application.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code, §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within 10 days of the date of this letter.
