By Order entered September 30, 1999, at Docket No. M-00981211, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ordered, inter alia:

That each licensed electric generation supplier shall submit annual reports showing sales in each electric distribution company's service territory, by customer class (residential, commercial and industrial) in total megawatt hours on 2/1/00, and 2/1/01 for the 12month calendar periods ending 12/31/99 and 12/31/00. respectively. That each jurisdictional electric distribution company (EDC) shall submit annual reports showing total megawatt hour deliveries to connected customers in its service territory by customer class (residential, commercial and industrial) on 2/1/00 and 2/1/01 for the 12-month calendar periods ending 12/31/99 and 12/31/00 respectively. That each EDC shall include in its annual reports, the total amount of megawatt hours, on a customer class basis (residential, commercial and industrial) sold to customers by the EDC as the default supplier or provider of last resort. In the event that a competitive default supplier (CDS) is serving customers within the EDC's territory, the CDS shall submit an annual report, including ...

According to our records, your company has not filed the required report for the year 1999. You are hereby directed to file an original and two copies of this report within 20 days of the date of this letter with the Commission's Secretary's Bureau at:

Therefore, reimbursement is required in the amount up to \$250,000.00

NOW THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that the Applicant must act in accordance with Section 2809 (c)(1)(i) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. 2809 (c)(1)(i), to assure compliance with applicable provisions of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. 101, et seq. and the rules and regulation of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission by the Applicant as a licensed electric generation supplier; to ensure the

payment of Gross Receipts Tax as required by Section 2810 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. 2810; and to ensure the supply of electricity at retail in accordance with contracts, agreements or arrangement. Payment of claims shall have the following priority: (I) The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; (II) Electric Distribution Companies for the reimbursement of Gross Receipts Tax; and (III) Private Individuals. Proceeds of the letter of credit may not be used to pay any penalties or fines levied against the Applicant for violations of the law, or for the payment of any other tax obligations owed to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

RE: License Bond or Other Financial Security

Dear Mr. Hoppe:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Jack Rich Inc will have been in place for approximately one year on 8/5/02.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.
