MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Philadelphia Gas Works, the Respondent (PGW) hereby requests a continuance of the hearing in this matter scheduled for Thursday, March 7, 2013. In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:

1. On October 9, 2012, the Commission served the Respondent with the Complaint filed in the above captioned matter, which is a billing dispute concerning a makeup bill.
2. On October 29, 2012, PGW filed an Answer to the Complaint in the above captioned matter.
3. By Notice dated December 31, 2012, the Commission scheduled an In Person Hearing in this matter for March 7, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Angela T. Jones, in the Commission's Philadelphia office.
4. On March 7, 2013, the witness for PGW experienced an emergency at home and was unable to attend work. Due to the nature of the complaint, PGW believes that another witness cannot be fully prepared in the few hours left before the scheduled hearing.
5. PGW has contacted the Complainant who has indicated that he objects to the request as he has taken the day off from work.
6. At this time, PGW believes that there is a possibility that the parties will resolve the instant matter by settlement with further discussion.
7. PGW's intention is to engage the Complainant in a settlement conference immediately prior to the commencement of the hearing to eliminate all of some of the unresolved issues of this matter with a PGW representative, a replacement for the PGW witness Anne Marie Cromley, Senior Customer Review Officer –

PGW.

8. At the end of the settlement conference, if parties have not reached a full settlement, PGW can assess whether if replacement representative may testify in the matter. If not, PGW may move for a continuance at that time.

WHEREFORE, in the event that PGW's replacement witness is unable to provide testimony on the unresolved issues of this matter, PGW respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for Thursday, March 7, 2013, in the above captioned matter be continued and rescheduled.




