Enclosed herewith are two (2) copies of Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 cancelling Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 5, issued by B & K Moving & Hauling, Inc. at A-00119130, and sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law.

An additional copy of said proposed tariff is also enclosed for your staff with the other two sets being forward to Mr. Robert Bingaman, Bureau of Technical Utility Services file.

B & K Moving & Hauling, Inc. is seeking rate increases in it released value rule from 30¢ to 60¢ per pound per article, an increase in the flat charge for hoisting and an increase in the piano/organ carry charges for the baby grand piano. Applicant also seeks an increase in the 4.5 cu. ft. box and wrap, small bubble per roll. Lastly, applicant is seeking an increase in its under 40 mile transportation service by the hour.

Also attached is a letter affidavit prepared by B & K Moving & Hauling, Inc. stating that its 2012 gross Pennsylvania revenues were less than \$500,000 and its operating ratio was not less than 93%.

Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 is being filed on sixty (60) days notice with a tentative effective date of May 13, 2013, unless further suspended.



- (1) Household goods, in use, between points in the counties of Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Montgomery and Bucks, included within a line which connects the municipal boundaries of Chester, West Chester, Paoli, Norristown, Doylestown and Morrisville but not including said places;
- (2) Household goods, in use, from points in the counties of Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Montgomery and Bucks, included within a line which connects the municipal boundaries of Chester, West Chester, Paoli, Norristown, Doylestown, and Morrisville, but not including said places, to other points in Pennsylvania and vice versa; and
- (3) Property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

THIS TARIFF ONLY APPLIES ON THE TRANSPORTATION OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS, IN USE MOVING DISTANCES OF 40 MILES AND LESS.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

RULE NO. 1 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

- (a) SHIPMENTS MOVING 40 MILES AND UNDER - Governed, except as otherwise provided herein by Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 issued by this carrier, supplements thereto and reissues thereof.
- (b) SHIPMENTS MOVING OVER 40 MILES - Refer to Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 3, issued by this carrier, supplements thereto and reissues thereof.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- (A) Rates and charges for additional services shown herein are in addition to all other rates. Rates and charges apply on shipments when released to a value not exceeding 60 cents per pound, per article. For rates to apply on shipments where the declared value exceeds 60 cents per pound, per article, see Item 290 in Governing Publications (Rule 1 above).

ITEM 10: PACKING AND UNPACKING (Exception to Item 200 of Governing Publication)

The charges and provisions of Item 200 apply as published except for the following:

Carrier will perform packing and unpacking at the direction of the shipper/receiver and the charge will be the cost of the container (See Item 40) plus the hourly rate shown Table A page 4 of this tariff for the labor used.

(A) ITEM 20: HOISTING OR LOWERING, where necessary.

Flat charge \$60.00 per article.

ITEM 30: PIANO OR ORGAN CARRY CHARGES

(A) SCHEDULE OF RATES - TABLE A
 (Applicable on all shipments - 40 miles and under)

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING shown in Column 1 plus the HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charge (Column 1) is in addition to Hourly Rates (Columns 2 and 3)

NOTE 2 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 & 4) are based on the day or days, as indicated,

NOTE 3 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 & 4) computed in 1/4 hour periods, fraction of 1/4 hour considered 1/4 hour.

NOTE 4 - When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named Columns 1 and 2 apply.

NOTE 5 - Minimum total transportation charges: Monday to Friday (except holidays) four hours at rates named in Column 3; Saturdays - 6 hours at rates named in Column 4; Sundays and Holidays - 8 hours at rates named in Column 2.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor(s) as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.
