Enclosed herewith are two (2) copies of Supplement 18 to Tariffffreight Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 cancelling Supplement 16 issued by Gardner Moving Company at A-00108945, and sent to you for fiing in compliance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law.

An additional copy of said proposed supplement is also enclosed for your staff with the other two sets being forwarded to Mr. Robert Bingaman, Bureau of Technical Utility Services file.

Applicant has proposed selective increases in packing, unpacking and container charges and shown with the symbol (A). Applicant also has proposed increases in its local under 40 mile hourly rates.

Also attached are two (2) letter affidavits. The first affidavit explains that its 2012 Pa. gross revenues were \$841,208.00 was correct, however, the revenues generated from "household goods in use" amounted to \$492,031.00. Your applicant neglected to separate the "property" revenues from the "household goods in use" revenues. Please note from a photocopy of applicants assessment report filed on February 13, 2013 it only show all revenues under the "household goods" column.

The now Bureau of Techincal Utility Services and previously the Bureau of Transportation and Safety have allowed household goods carriers whose revenues generated from the transportation of household goods in use ifuunder the \$500,000-1, threshold would be acceptable not including the revenues generated from "property" be excluded in the same fashion this storage, inner office moving, transportation of voting machines and more.

- (1) To transport, as a Class D carrier, coal, coke and other solid fuels, contractors road building materials and supplies, between points in the city of Pittsburgh, and within fifteen (15) miles by the usually traveled highways of the City-County Building in the city of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County.
- (2) To transport, as a Class B carrier, property from the Klein-Logan Company, to and from railroad stations in the city of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County.

Subject to Notes 1 to 8 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2 and 3.

Hourly rates apply only <u>from</u> time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) <u>until</u> completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.
