**PREHEARING MEMORANDUM
OF THE
BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CHRISTOPHER P. PELL:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) respectfully submits the following Prehearing Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding. I. INTRODUCTION

On January 31, 2013, Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW or Company) submitted pre-filed information regarding its 2013-2014 Purchased Gas Cost Rate filing pursuant to

Section 1307(f) of the Public Utility Code. By filing dated February 28, 2013, PGW submitted its definitive filing including its supporting testimony.

A Prehearing Conference is scheduled for March 19, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., with Administrative Law Judge Christopher P. Pell presiding.

II. ISSUES

The following list represents I&E's preliminary determination of the potential issues in this case. The listing is as complete as can be made at this time. I&E reserves the right to address other issues as it deems appropriate if any such relevant issues arise.

The issues are as follows:

- Lost and Unaccounted for Gas
- Retainage
- Off-system sales and capacity release
- Proper computation of C-factor and E-factor and migration riders
- Supplier refunds
- Interest rate factor for over/under collections
- Migration sales volumes
- Sales volumes projections

III. WITNESSES

It is currently expected that I&E may call the following expert witnesses without being limited thereto:

Ethan Cline, Fixed Utility Valuation Engineer
Lisa Boyd, Fixed Utility Financial Analyst

The I&E witnesses may be contacted through the information listed above for Ms. Matz. The witness list is provided without the benefit of complete discovery or analysis of the positions of potential other parties to this proceeding. Accordingly, I&E

reserves the right to call additional witnesses or withdraw the name of the witnesses listed above.

IV. EVIDENCE

I&E expects to present written direct, rebuttal, and surrebuttal testimony and accompanying exhibits at the evidentiary hearing. Moreover, I&E intends to rely, without limitation, on the Company's filing, answers to data requests and interrogatories, annual reports, and other documents submitted to the Commission, other relevant Commission filings, any other relevant Commonwealth agency letters or reports, general financial market information sources, and other public documents and reports.

V. SCHEDULE

The parties have exchanged communications regarding a proposed schedule. Based upon those discussions, I&E believes that the following schedule is or can be agreed to:

VI. SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS

For purposes of satisfying in-hand requirements for discovery responses, prepared testimony and briefs, I&E agrees to accept e-mailed delivery of documents with a follow-

up hard copy provided by regular first class mail on the condition that electronic documents are received no later than 4:00 p.m. on their scheduled due date.

VII. DISCOVERY

I&E does not propose any modifications to the Commission's regulations regarding discovery. However, in the event another party proposes modifications to discovery rules that have the effect of abbreviating the time-frames established in the Commission's regulations relating to discovery, I&E respectfully requests that the following additional modification be adopted:

Discovery-related pleadings, i.e., objections, motions, answers to motions, served on a Friday or on any business day preceding a state holiday shall be deemed served on the next business day.

VIII. SETTLEMENT

I&E is willing to engage in good faith efforts to resolve this matter through settlement. In the event settlement discussions fail to result in a full and complete resolution of the matter, I&E is prepared to fully or partially litigate this proceeding.


