

Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1.1 et seq. and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq. In view of the cancellation of respondent's Certificate of Public Convenience, he is specifically prohibited from rendering service as a common carrier by motor vehicle in intrastate commerce in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Should Respondent wish to again begin transportation operations in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Respondent must file a new application for authority in order to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience. The Respondent must pay all outstanding assessments and fines before this Commission will act on an application for authority. Payment must be made by certified check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and mailed to the PA Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.

If you disagree with this determination you may appeal to the Commission, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.44 or, if you believe that you have received this letter in error, you must write a letter stating the reasons you believe this letter is in error and requesting that it be rescinded within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The letter shall be sent to Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
