Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

Please use this letter as my affidavit that for calendar year 2012 our Pennsylvania Gross Revenues were \$2,185,945.00. Your applicant is seeking a partial increase in our container charges. Some containers were not increased. One new container was added to our list of packing containers. I am aware of the PA Code, Title 52, Section 23.67. Applying 1% to our PA P.U.C. revenues results in the amount of \$21,859.45. Applying the eleven(11) percent times our 2012 packing container revenues of \$3,489.57 results in an adjustment of \$3,873.42, which is less than 1% of our PA Gross Revenue of \$2,185,945.00, therefore meeting the application of PA Code, Title 52, Section 23.67.

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

Except as otherwise provided herein for rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods in use, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), loose-leaf revisions thereto and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE •

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when value declared exceeds sixty (60) cents, see provisions in Governing Publication.

ITEM 30 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

Subject to Notes 1 and 6 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2 and 3.
