Please use this letter as my affidavit that for calendar year 2012 our Pennsylvania Gross Revenues were \$2,185,945.00. Your applicant is seeking a partial increase in our container charges. Some containers were not increased. One new container was added to our list of packing containers. I am aware of the PA Code, Title 52 Section 23.67. Applying 1% to our PA P.U.C. revenues results in the amount of \$21,859.45. Applying the eleven(11) percent times our 2012 packing container revenues of \$3,489.57 results in an adjustment of \$3,873.42, which is less than 1% of our PA Gross Revenue of \$2,185,945.00, therefore meeting the application of PA Code, Title 52, Section 23.67.
