Under Rate LGA, Riley Natural Gas Company will be aggregating local gas supplies on behalf of pool operators on Peoples' system. Further, Riley Natural Gas Company has indicated that it will not be selling gas to any end use customers through its local gas aggregation pool. Accordingly, Peoples is not requiring Riley Natural Gas Company to post a bond under Paragraph 7.
