5. This proceeding concerns the proposed merger of Equitable, with and into Peoples

Natural Gas Company, LLC ("Peoples"), as well as related transactions, as set forth in the

Application.

6. IBEW desires to participate in this proceeding to ensure that its interests and the

interests of its members, as employees and/or customers of Equitable, are fully protected and

represented in this matter. IBEW anticipates issues being raised in this proceeding that will or

may affect its interests as a representatives of its members' interests, including but not limited to

employees of the natural gas distribution company and on any authorized collective bargaining

agent representing those employees." 66 Pa. C.S. § 2210(a)(2).

9. No other party represents the interests of IBEW in this proceeding or can speak for

IBEW as to the effects of the proposed transaction on IBEW and its members.

10. IBEW intends to actively participate in this proceeding on such matters that affect its

interests. Such participation may include conducting discovery, presenting testimony, cross-

examining witnesses, and filing briefs and other pleadings.

11. IBEW acknowledges that a labor union, Utility Workers Union of America, Local 666

("UWUA"), representing employees of Peoples has filed a Petition to Intervene in this

proceeding. IBEW and UWUA are using the same counsel and will coordinate their efforts in

this proceeding to the extent possible.
