Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) is no longer pursuing certain civil penalties that are associated with alleged violations of Turtle Creek Industrial Railroad Company (Respondent), which are set forth in the complaint filed on August 27, 2012 in the above-captioned matter.

These civil penalties request that Respondent pay 15% of its outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008, and July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009 fiscal years. Fifteen percent of these balances total \$975.

In addition, I&E is withdrawing the \$1,000 civil penalty associated with Respondent's alleged failure to file an assessment report by March 31, 2008. Accordingly, I&E is reducing the overall civil penalty by \$1,975, to \$70.
