UGI Utilities, Inc. ("UGI") provides this letter in satisfaction of the demands set forth in the Formal Complaint filed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) in the above-referenced matter ("Complaint").

Regarding the subject matter of the Complaint, through this satisfaction letter, UGI does not concede to have engaged in any action or omission in violation of the Public Utility Code, regulations promulgated thereunder, or any other applicable law or regulation.

In specific reference to the relief requested in sub-paragraph 19.a. of the Complaint, UGI herewith attaches a check in the amount of \$50,000.00 made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


Regarding the specific items of relief requested in subparagraphs 19.b-19.g of the Complaint, UGI previously had agreed with I&E to perform the same remedial tasks in a settlement agreement that was rejected by the Commission by order entered June 13, 2012 in Docket No. M-2012-2141712. In conformance with that prior agreement, UGI has either already performed the task, or is prepared to perform the task within the next several months.
