Dear Mr. Barthrop:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Commonwealth Energy Company expires on 6/25/02.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code 54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. 2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

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In furtherance of our telephone inquiries related to updating the Electric Service Provider License of Commonwealth Energy Corporation, doing Business as electricAmerica in the State of Pennsylvania we offer the following explanation of the new ownership structure of Commonwealth Energy Corporation.

Commonwealth Energy Corporation ("Commonwealth Energy") provides this notice to the Public Utility Commission of Pennsylvania ("PAPUC") of a change in its corporate owner and organization, as that information was originally provided in its Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") application. Commonwealth Energy is in the process of reorganizing its corporate structure and is creating a holding company known as Commerce Energy Group, Inc. ("Commerce"), a Delaware corporation. Under the reorganization, Commonwealth Energy's shareholders will become the owner of Commerce and Commerce, in turn, will become the sole owner of Commonwealth Energy. Commonwealth Energy will continue to be the entity responsible for providing retail electric service to Pennsylvania's consumers, as set forth in its EGS application, and no other fact in that original application will change under the reorganization. Commonwealth Energy will retain all the technical expertise and financial information as reflected in its license application. Commerce will not be providing retail electric service, or any other products or services, to consumers in this state. Commonwealth is therefore providing this information solely to inform the Commission about the change in its ownership structure, since it reflects a change from the application provided in Commonwealth's original application filed on July 1st, 1999.

Commerce Energy Group, Inc. is solely in the business of owning Commonwealth Energy, which is registered in this state and licensed to provide retail electric service to this state's consumers. Commerce Energy Group, Inc. has been qualified in the State of Delaware as a foreign corporation and authorized to do business in Pennsylvania (see attached qualification and authorization), but it will not be providing electric service, or any other products or services, to the consumers in this state. Instead, Commonwealth will continue to provide such electric service and other products or services as permitted under state law.

The amended report with a spreadsheet showing our calculations are included with this letter.

According to regulation 52 Pa. Code \$54.40(d), the security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported annual gross receipts. Therefore, the enclosed bond penalty is for the amount of \$6,643,256.00.

Regrettably wholesale market conditions are making it difficult to compete in the electric marketplace. The Price to Compare offered by PECO is so much lower than Commonwealth Energy Corp. d.b.a. electricAmerica can offer its smaller customers (non-contracted month to month residential & smaller commercial) we feel forced to take somewhat drastic measures. It is important to us that our customers receive the best rate available, and rather than continue to raise prices above those of PECO, we have elected to cancel service to these customers effective the first scheduled meter read, on or after March 30, 2005.

We will be mailing the appropriate advanced written notification, with options, as required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PA PUC) to approximately 17,850 customers the last full week of February. A copy of the letter, approved by PA PUC and PECO staffs, is included here with. By utilizing a local printer/mailhouse delivery is expedited to within a day or two in most cases. We have requested "Important 30-Day Notice Enclosed" be added to the envelopes to encourage customers to read the material immediately.

electricAmerica has been working closely with the PA PUC and PECO Energy to ensure this matter is handled appropriately. On February 3, 2005 we informed Robert Bennett at the PAPUC/Licensing/Electric Competition, Jim Farley at the Bureau of Consumer Affairs/PAPUC, and PECO (EGC) of our intentions. Subsequently Mr. Farley forwarded the information to David Mick also at the PAPUC.

electricAmerica has been licensed, number A-110117, to supply electricity to PA consumers since September 15, 1999. We are <u>not</u> exiting the Pennsylvania energy market now. We will continue to service approximately 15,000 customers within the PECO service territory where we continue to offer competitive rates, and we will to strive to establish competitive offerings to customers of all classes as the market conditions allow. We have done a great deal of advanced research and believe we are well prepared to handle this matter appropriately. We are attempting to do everything in our power to treat our smaller customers as fairly as possible and follow PA Code.

Additionally Commerce Energy Group, Inc., the holding company for Commonwealth Energy Corp. and electricAmerica, has an agreement to acquire the assets of ACN Energy, a division of ACN, Inc. Commerce Energy Group will eventually be transitioning ACN Energy and re-branding Commonwealth Energy Corp. d.b.a. electricAmerica to Commerce Energy, Inc. (CEI). While this is a totally separate matter, we wanted to be certain you were made aware of it.





Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Section 54.34, Commonwealth Energy Corporation ("CEC") d/b/a electricAmerica, Inc. ("electricAmerica"), provides the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") notice that electricAmerica has changed its name to Commerce Energy, Inc. ("CEI"). CEI respectfully requests that the Commission modify electricAmerica's Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") license to reflect this name change.

On July 1, 1999, CEC filed an Application with the PUC requesting approval to offer EGS services in Pennsylvania. Dear Mr. Barthrop:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Commonwealth Energy Company expires on June 25, 2005.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services. Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.



Dear Secretary McNulty:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Section 54.34, ACN Energy, Inc. ("ACN Energy"), respectfully notifies the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") that it is assigning its electric generation customers to Commerce Energy, Inc. ("CEI"), a licensed Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") in Pennsylvania.

On November 19, 1998, the PUC granted ACN Energy an EGS license at Docket No. A-110102. On February 9, 2005, ACN Energy entered into an agreement under which CEI acquired the assets of ACN Energy.¹ As a result of this acquisition, ACN Energy is assigning all of its EGS customers to CEI, beginning the week of June 1, 2005. Pursuart Control of this transfer to the Commission.

ACN Energy is also providing notice of this assignment to its customers during the week of April 25, 2005. Because this assignment will begin on June 1, 2005, ACN Energy's approximate 8,000 customers will be receiving more than 30 days notice of the assignment. A copy of this customer notice has been provided to the Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services and is also attached hereto as Attachment A. Moreover, CEI will continue to provide service to ACN Energy's electric customers pursuant to the terms and conditions of ACN Energy's Disclosure Statement. A copy of this Disclosure Statement, which has been modified only to reflect the change to CEI, is attached hereto as Attachment B.

Finally, ACN Energy's current customers are located in only one Electric Distribution Company's ("EDCs") service territory, which is that of PECO Energy Company ("PECO"). ACN Energy has informed PECO of this assignment so that PECO can make any necessary system changes.

¹ CEI has an EGS license at Docket No. A-110117, which is currently under the name of Commonwealth Energy Corporation d/b/a electricAmerica, Inc. On April 20, 2005, CEI filed notice with the Commission regarding its official name change and requesting that the PUC reissue the EGS license in the name of CEI.

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Disclosure Statement for Electric Generation Service

This is an agreement for electric generation service, between Commerce Energy, Inc., ("Commerce Energy") and

Background

We at Commerce Energy are licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to offer and supply electric generation services in Pennsylvania. Our PUC license number is A-110117.

- We set the generation prices and charges that you pay. The Public Utility Commission regulates distribution prices and services. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services.
- You will receive a single bill from your electric distribution company ("EDC") for our charges as well as the EDC's charges. Commerce Energy reserves the right to assume the billing function for our services.
- Rights of Recision You may cancel this agreement at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving this disclosure.

Definitions

- Generation Charge Charge for production of electricity.
- Transmission Charge Charge for moving high voltage electricity from a generation facility to the distribution lines of an electric distribution company.
- Customer Charge A fixed monthly charge for costs incurred by Commerce Energy, Inc., in servicing your account.

TERMS OF SERVICE

1. Basic Service Prices

a. <u>Generation and Transmission Charges</u>

You will pay a variable rate ("price") starting at a price of at least four cents per kWh for electric generation and transmission services, which may be increased up to fourteen cents per kWh due to increases in the wholesale price of electricity. This price includes estimated total state tax. This price excludes state sales and local taxes, if applicable. For current prices, visit our website at <u>www.commerceenergy.com</u> or call our Commerce Energy Rate Hotline at 1-800-353-2874 Ext. 6583.

b. <u>Customer Charge</u>

You will pay <u>\$2.78</u> per month for the customer charge.

c. <u>Security Deposits</u>

We may perform a credit check. Based upon the results of a credit check, and prior to switching your account to Commerce Energy, you may be required to either: (1) pay a security deposit; or (2) agree to pre-authorized credit card payments for your monthly bills. Commerce Energy will follow applicable regulations.

2. Length of Agreement

This is a month to month agreement. You will buy your electricity generation services for the above street address from Commerce Energy beginning on your first meter read date on or after ______ and will continue until this agreement is cancelled by either one of us according to paragraph 5.

3. Limitation of Liability

Commerce Energy assumes no liability or responsibility for losses or consequential damages arising from the following items associated with your local electric distribution company: operations and maintenance of their system; any interruption of service; termination of service; or deterioration of service. Nor does Commerce Energy assume responsibility or liability for losses or consequential damages arising from any in-home or building wiring damages. The remedy in any claim or suit by you against Commerce Energy will be limited to direct actual damages. By entering into this agreement, you waive any right to any other remedy. In no event will either Commerce Energy or you be liable for consequential, incidental or punitive damages. These limitations apply without regard to the cause of any liability or damages.

4. Penalties, Fees and Exceptions

You agree that you will pay your bill on or before the due date shown on the bill. If you do not pay the full amount of the bill by the due date, you will be charged interest at a rate of 1.5% per month on unpaid balances or otherwise in accordance with your EDC's policies and procedures. If PECO Energy is billing for Commerce Energy, you will be charged interest at a rate of 1.25% per month on unpaid balances.

5. Cancellation Provisions

You may cancel this agreement for any reason by giving Commerce Energy 30 days written notice. Commerce Energy may cancel this agreement for any reason by giving you two written notices. The first notice will be sent to you between 52 and 90 days before the effective date of the cancellation, and the second will be sent to you at least seven days after the first notice and at least 45 days before the effective date of the cancellation. If you do not pay your bill on time, we may cancel this agreement for non-

payment by providing 10 days written notice. If Commerce Energy cancels your service for nonpayment, you must pay the balance owed under this agreement plus our reasonable collection costs up to \$50.00.

6. Agreement Expiration/Change in Terms

If we propose to change the terms of our service, we will send you two written notices. The first notice will be sent to you between 52 and 90 days before the effective date of the changes, and the second will be sent to you at least seven days after the first notice and at least 45 days before the effective date of the changes. We will explain your options in these advance notices.

7. Dispute Procedures

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Contact us with any questions concerning our terms of service. You may call the Public Utility Commission if you are not satisfied after discussing the terms of service with us.

Dear Secretary McNulty:

On April 25, 2005, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") issued a letter requesting an update on the status of Commerce Energy, Inc.'s ("CEI") Electric Generation Supplier ("EGS") bond, which is currently in place with the Commission.¹

CEI understands that the Commission requested a response to this matter within fifteen days from the date of this letter, which would have been Tuesday, May 10, 2005. CEI greatly apologizes for the delay, which has resulted in providing this response slightly after the fifteenday time period. CEI has recently undergone some internal modifications; therefore, the Commission's letter of April 25 was sent to a person who is no longer directly responsible for these matters. CEI understands that failure to respond to the PUC's letter within the requested timeframe could cause the PUC to initiate formal proceedings; however, CEI respectfully requests that the PUC consider this letter to be an appropriate and adequate response that would negate any further action by the PUC. In addition, as set forth below, CEI has identified the appropriate contact person to receive any additional information regarding this matter. CEI can assure the Commission that any requests sent to this address will allow CEI to respond in a prompt and expeditious manner.

With respect to CEI's security level, the PUC notes that CEI's bond is in place through June 25, 2005, and requests that CEI provide an update regarding the approved security that will be in place after June 25, 2005. CEI is in the process of renewing this instrument, and CEI fully intends to have this renewal completed prior to June 25, 2005. CEI will provide evidence of this renewal to the Commission upon completion.

The PUC's letter also references Commission regulations that require the security level of each EGS to be based upon 10% of the EGS's reported gross receipts. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 2810(c)(6) and 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(b), CEI filed its Annual Report on April 30, 2005, which indicated CEI's gross receipts for 2004. CEI will undertake the measures necessary to ensure that the renewed bond meets this requirement.
