To Parties of Record:

On April 17, 2013, my office received Exceptions from Mr. Douglas Park to the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Barnes in the above captioned matter. Our review of the filing revealed that no certificate of service or other indication that the parties of record to the case were served with Mr. Park's Exceptions. Therefore, we have enclosed a copy of the Exceptions to constitute service for purposes of 52 Pa. Code §5.533.

Although the Exceptions were due to be filed by April 15, 2013, the Commission will consider them timely filed.
