

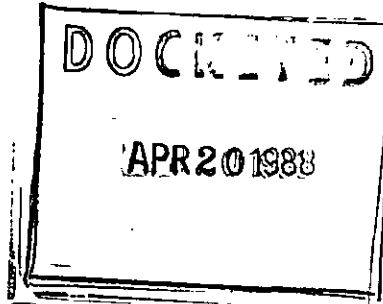

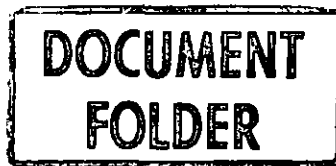

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER MODIFYING
CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE

BY THE COMMISSION:


It appearing that part of the rights granted to Phoenix Transport, Inc., under the certificate of public convenience issued at A-00105900 have been transferred to South Hills Movers, Inc., at A-00099073, F. 2, Am-E, and are now contained under the certificate of public convenience issued to it; and that the transferor is retaining certain operating authority; and the matters and things involved having been duly considered by the Commission; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That upon compliance with the conditions and requirements as set forth in the order at A-00099073, F. 2, Am-E, the operating rights and the certificate of public convenience at A-00105900 be and are hereby modified so as to eliminate rights number 3, 10, and 11, and that all of the remaining rights be subject to the following condition:

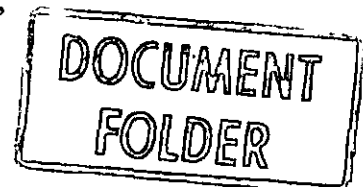
That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport household goods and office furnishings, in use.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the transferor shall amend its tariff to comply with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of the Commission relating to the filing and acceptance of a tariff.
