#### ORDER

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed June 15, 2007. Public notice of the application was given in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* of July 14, 2007, with protests due by July 30, 2007. No protests were filed. The unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing.

#### **DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS**

Cadden Bros. Moving & Storage, Inc. (applicant or Cadden Bros.) seeks the initial right to transport household goods in use by acquiring, through transfer, the household goods in use rights held by James D. Cadden, t/d/b/a Cadden's Moving & Storage. (Cadden's Moving & Storage). Applicant's founding shareholders, Patrick A. Cadden and James D. Cadden, Jr., have over 60 years combined experience, from positions as laborer to positions as management, in the household goods industry through their previous experience with Cadden's Moving & Storage. Cadden's Moving & Storage (transferor) is a family owned business and the current application involves a transfer from Mary Cadden, executrix of estate of James D. Cadden, to her sons.

Cadden Bros. will retain all business assets currently held by Cadden's Moving & Storage, as well as continue to employ all existing employees. The list of property and equipment to be transferred includes a 10,000 sq. ft. warehouse situated on 2.95 acres of land, five operating straight trucks, four non-operating straight trucks, three furniture trailers, one tractor, and various associated equipment such as dollies, pads, hand trucks, crates, etc. At present, the number of employees to be retained at transfer consists of four drivers, six laborers, one clerical person, and one admin/managerial person. The applicant also intends to continue all pre-existing safety programs. The transfer of all assets, employees, and safety programs, as well as continued family ownership, is expected to allow a seamless transition from entity to entity, of what will essentially be operated as an ongoing concern.

In conjunction with the transferor and the United States Internal Revenue Service (IRS), Cadden Bros. has negotiated a tax settlement in the amount of \$39,000 for outstanding federal tax obligations owed by the transferor. The purchase price of \$39,000 for transferor's rights shall be used to satisfy said tax debt. An additional tax debt of approximately \$10,000 also remains outstanding to the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue and constitutes the majority of the remaining \$11,000 of debt, which the applicant will accept liability for upon transfer. To satisfy the payment of these expenses the applicant has secured financing in the amount of \$50,000 to purchase the transferor's rights and to clear the several pre-existing tax liabilities. The applicant will also assume all existing vehicle and real-estate leases, which will be paid with the proceeds from the company's operation.

A review of the record before us indicates that the applicant possesses the technical expertise, experience, facilities, sufficient capital and other resources necessary to provide the proposed service.

The authority to be transferred has been operated by the transferor; therefore, it is presumed that there is a continuing need, which may be overcome only by evidence to the contrary. In re: Byerly, 270 A.2d 186 (Pa. 1970); Hostetter v. Pa. P.U.C., 49 A.2d 862 (Pa. Super 1947). Since the record is void of any such evidence, this presumption of continuing public need applies in this transfer proceeding.

We advise the applicant to become familiar with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a common carrier as authorized by this grant of authority. Failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of authority. To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, (1) uncrated household furniture and uncrated household appliances, purchased from retailers or wholesalers for household use from points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, to the homes of such purchasers in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; (2) household goods in use, between points in the counties of Luzerne, Susquehanna, Monroe, and Wyoming, and from points in said counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa, right (2) subject to the following conditions: that no right, power or privilege is granted to transport from or between points in Monroe County; that no right, power or privilege is granted to transport to, from or between points in the city of Nanticoke, Luzerne County, and points within three statute miles of the limits of said city; that no right, power or privilege is granted to transport to, from or between points in the borough of Duryea, Luzerne County, and within eight miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said borough; that no right, power or privilege is granted to transport to or from points in the counties of Pike, Wayne, Columbia, and Lackawanna; (3) household goods in use, between points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, and from points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; (4) household goods in use, from points in the borough of Olyphant, Lackawanna County, and within three statute miles of the said borough, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; which is to be a transfer of all the rights authorized under the certificate issued at A-00099165, to James D. Cadden, t/d/b/a Cadden's Moving & Storage, subject to the same limitations and conditions.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation authorized by this order until the following is submitted to the Commission:

- 1. Form E, as evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance.
- 2. Form H, as evidence of cargo liability insurance.
- 3. A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.
- 4. Evidence of payment of all outstanding tax debt owed by the transferor, James D. Cadden, t/d/b/a Cadden's Moving & Storage to the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That applicant must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review. Applicant will be contacted by the Commission's Bureau of Transportation and Safety, which will schedule a review to be completed within 180 days of the date your certificate is issued. Failure to submit to a Safety Fitness Review or to attain a satisfactory evaluation will result in cancellation of the certificate.

#### **MOTION OF COMMISSIONER TYRONE J. CHRISTY**

Before us is an application for the transfer of the certificate of public convenience held by James D. Cadden, t/d/b/a Cadden's Moving & Storage (Transferor), to Cadden Brothers Moving and Storage, Inc. (Applicant). The Applicant represents that it has secured financing that in part will be used to satisfy an outstanding tax debt owed to the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue by the Transferor, and that the Applicant will accept liability for this tax debt upon transfer of the certificate.

To ensure that this outstanding debt is satisfied, I believe that it is appropriate to condition the issuance of the certificate of public convenience to the Applicant, and the cancellation of the certificate held by the Transferor, upon the filing of proof of payment of the tax debt to the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue.

#### THEREFORE, I MOVE THAT:

- 1. The Application of Cadden Brothers Moving and Storage, Inc. (Applicant) be approved.

- 3. Upon compliance with these requirements, a certificate shall issue to the Applicant, and the certificate granted to the Transferor at A-00099165 shall be canceled and the record marked closed.

#### AGREEMENT FOR THE SALE OF A BUSINESS

WHEREAS, James Cadden and Patrick Cadden are 50% owners of the business known as Cadden Brothers Moving and Storage. Inc..: and

WHEREAS, Seller and Buyer are also 50% owners of a business of P & JLLC which owns the real estate on which Cadden Brothers Moving and Storage Inc, conducts business; and

WHEREAS, Soller intends to sell any and all interest he has in the Company and any and all interest in the LLC to the Buyer and the sale of the interest in the LLC is reflected in a separate Agreement.

WHEREAS, Buyer as part of the sale of the LLC, will be executing a mortgage on behalf of the LLC, and

WHEREAS, to purchase the stock of the Company and for other capital improvements Buyer will be borrowing monies which the real property will secure.

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

#### 1. Definitions

The term "Company" as used herein refers to Cadden Brothers Moving and Storage, Inc.

The tenn "LLC" refers to P & J LLC in which Buyer and Seller are 50% owners and which owns the real estate on which the Company is located and which is subject to a separate agreement of sale.

The term "Mortgage" as used herein refers to the mortgage given by the LLC to the Seller for the the sale of his interest in the LLC.

The term "New Loan" as used herein refers to the loan Buyer will obtain to pay the selling price of this agreement and additional monies for capital improvements to the Company or LLC and such loan will not exceed \$110,000.00.

The term "Secured personal property" refers to truck unit 201, a 2006 Hino 278 vehicle, VIN 5PBNJ8JT762S50181, Truck Unit 202, a 2007 Hino 258, VIN 5PBNV8JT772S50610, a Truck Unit 203, a 2007 Hino 258, VIN 5PVND8JR072S50049, and 2006 Kentucky Trailer VIN 1KKVE53256L221186 which are subject to loans held by the First Liberty Bank and Company.

#### 2. Stock Sales

For and in consideration of the sum of Fifty [Thousand (\$50,000.00.) Dollars in hand paid by Buyer to Seller. Buyer agrees to purchase from Seller and Seller agrees to sell any and all of his shares of stock in the Company.

#### 3. Indemnification

The Buyer and/or the Company agrees to remove and release Seller's obligation under any loans relating to the Secured Property and will indomnify and hold Seller harmless from any and all claims, actions and causes of action relating to the Secured Property.

#### 4. Treatment of Income and Expenses

Seller and Buyer agree to prorate their respective shares of the income and expenses of the Company for the calendar year in which the closing takes place as of the date of the closing of this transaction in accordance with their respective stock ownership interest in the said corporation.

#### 5. Closing

The consummation of the transactions contemplated by this Agreement shall take place at the offices of Mattisc & Kelly, P.C. on or before 12/31/12 or approval of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of the of the transfer of stock of Cadden Brothers Moving & Storage, Inc. from Seller to Buyer whichever is later.

#### 6. Documents

At the closing, the following deliveries shall be made and the following actions shall be taken, each of which shall be deemed to have occurred and to have been taken simultaneously and none of which shall be deemed to have been completed until all such deliveries and actions have been completed.

- A. Items to be delivered by Seller: At the closing, Seller shall deliver to Buyer the following:
- (i) Such Bills of Sale, stock certificates, or limited power of attorney necessary to transfer any shares of stock in the company.
  - (ii) Such other documents, certificates and instruments as Buyer may reasonably request.

- B. Items to be delivered by Buyer: At the closing, the Buyer shall deliver to the Seller:
  - (i) Such other documents, certificates and instruments as Selier may reasonably request.

#### 7. Cell phones

Buyer and the Company will continue to pay for one (1) cell phone for Seller use as such presently exists as of December 31, 2012 provided Seller does not enhance the cell phone contract currently existing on the Company's phone line.

#### 8. Insurance

- A. Buyer and Company continues to pay the premium on a term life insurance policy on Seller's life with a death benefit of \$250,000,00 until October 9, 2032 when said policy will expire. (hereinafter "Life Insurance") Buyer shall continue to be listed as the beneficiary on the said term life insurance policy.
- B. If there is a outstanding balance due on the Mortgage at the time of Seller's death, Buyer will pay, from the proceeds of the Life Insurance, the balance due on the Mortgage to Seller's wife, Terry Cadden, should she survive Seller or to Seller's estate should Terry Cadden not survive Seller from the proceeds of the term life insurance policy.
- C. The Buyer shall then be paid from the balance of the Life Insurance after payment of the balance on the Mortgage, if any, an amount equal to 45% on the outstanding balance on the New Loan, provided such is not in default, else no credit will be given.
- D. The balance of the proceeds of the Life Insurance after payments under subsection B or C or both to be divided equally between Euyer and Terry Cadden or to Seller's Estate should Terry Cadden not survive Seller.
- E. If there is no balance on the Mortgage or New Loan at the time of Seller's death the proceeds of the Life Insurance shall be split evenly between Buyer and Terry Cadden should Terry Cadden survive or to the Seller's Estate should Terry Cadden not survive Seller.
- F. Buyer and/or Company shall provided to Sellers when requested proof of coverage and further the Life Insurance will list Seller 8.5 Loss Payee so as to provide Seller with notice cancellation.

#### 9. Amendments

This Agreement may be amended only by a written instruments executed by Seller and Buyer.

#### 10. Guarantee

The Company hereby unconditionally and without limitation guarantee any claim or any

obligation of Buyer forth under the terms of this Agreement.

#### 11. Fees and Expenses

Seller and Buyer shall pay their own fees and expenses incident to negotiation, preparation and execution of this Agreement, including, without limitation, attorneys and accounting fees, whether or not such transactions are consummated. Neither Buyer not Seller shall have any liability to the other for costs, expenses, loss of anticipated profits or otherwise if the transactions contemplated by this Agreement are terminated pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement in a manner which does not constitute a default hereunder. In no event shall Seller or Buyer be liable to each other for special, consequential, incidental or punitive damages, including, without limitation, damages for lost profits or lost savings.

#### 12. Warrant v as to Broker

Each of Seller and Buyer represent and warrant to the other that no person, including without limitation any broker, finder or investment banker, has brought the parties hereto together or initiated or been instrumental in completing the transactions contemplated by this Agreement for which a broker's or finder's fee is payable by Seller or Buyer.

#### 13. Notice

Any notice, request, instruction or other decument to be given hereunder shall be in writing and delivered personally or sent by telecopy or first class mail, postage prepaid if to Buyer, addressed to Cadden Brothers Moving & Storage, Inc. 1106 Mid Valley Drive, Olyphant, PA 18447 attention Patrick Cadden, if to Seller addressed to James Cadden 1018 Alder Street, Scranton, PA 18505.

#### 14. Entire Agreement

This Agreement embodies the entire Agreement among the parties and supersedes without limitation all prior agreements, representations or warranties, whether written or oral, between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and there have been and there are no agreements, representations, or warranties among the parties other than those set forth herein.

#### 15. Non Assignability

Neither his Agreement nor any of the parties' rights hereunder shall be assignable by any party hereto without the prior written consent of the other party, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

#### 16. Execution

The parties agree to execute such other documents, should take such other action and give such other further assurances as may be reasonably necessary or desirable for a consummation of the

transactions contemplated hereby and to carry out the terms and purposes of this Agreement.

My duties at Cadden's varied from helper to straight truck driver and then later on to a tractor trailer driver. As I gained more experience I learned to do sales and different paperwork associated with the moving and storage business. Then from July 2006 to December 2007 I served as President of Cadden's under the ownership of my mother Mary Cadden. Then in January of 2008 my bother James Cadden Jr. and I took ownership of the business from my mother. As president of the company I oversee day to day operations of the business.

Also, from 1986 to 1989 and then again from 1992 to 2000 I worked part time transporting freight at UPS. It was during this time that I learned the ins and outs of logistics. This experience has allowed me expand my business, by implementing a home delivery division.

I also rent a 6,000 square foot building in the same industrial park were we house our permanent storage accounts. The storage is placed into wooden crates that are 7ft.x5ft.

Customers contact us by phone as a result of either word of mouth recommendations or by looking up our ad in either the phone book or on the internet.

We have four computers for our book keeping. We have 2 individuals in the office that handle PUC records, finances and other daily book keeping.

Once the customer's requests are taken we then inform our drivers every morning of the tasks for the day. During the course of the day if there are changes to the mornings instruction we contact the drivers using the cell phones provided to them by the company.
