RE: EXCEPTIONS OF Teresa Sugar vs Duquesne Light Company, Docket No. F-2012-2330853

Dear Secretary,

I would like to file Exceptions to the Recommended Decision of the Office of Administrative Law Judge regarding my complaint Docket No. F-2012-2330853.

I still feel that I should be given a new payment plan. Both of the Exhibits that I wanted to submit were denied. I feel that they should have been considered and entered into the court record by Special Agent Tiffany A. Hunt. I did not object to any items offered by Duquesne Light Company.

On Page 5 of the decision under Objections to Complainant's Exhibits it was determined that my First Exhibit was not relevant (List of Medications and Equipment used by my brother) and that my Second Exhibit was inadmissible (E-Mail from Marie Tamilya) I find Exception to this.

Exhibit 1 listed all of my brother George's medications and medical equipment – Oxygen Machine Used through out the day and a C-PAK Machine used at night. He also takes Insulin 5 Times a Day (Two Different Types – LANTUS and HUMALOG) that must be refrigerated. If I have my electric shut off he can not have his oxygen or keep his insulin from spoiling.

Exhibit 2 was a copy of the E-MAIL I received from Marie Tamilya, Regulatory Consumer Relations from Duquesne Light Company dated November 2, 2012 at 9:00 pm. The E-Mail gave me the impression that Duquesne Light Company wanted to resolve the matter. She gave me false hope that my situation could be worked out. I made several attempts to contact Marie Tamilya by phone with negative results. I left her messages on her voice mail and she never returned my calls.

I feel that had my Two Exhibits been accepted the decision my have been different.

I paid \$ 150.00 dollars on my bill back in October of 2012 and applied to the Dollar Energy Fund for help. I received a letter from the fund telling me that Duquesne Light Company wanted me to pay another \$ 394.00 dollars before they would help

me. I do not qualify for any other assistance. Dollar Energy was my only hope for help and they turned me down.

There is no way I can come up with the total amount due on my bill at one time. I take home only \$ 731.00 every two weeks. Not \$1,086.23 every two weeks as listed on page 4 of the decision, item 12.

My brother has been fighting for the last four years for SSD and SSI. He was denied the SSD and now may be getting SSI benefits in the near future which will allow us to get back on track with the Duquesne Light Company.

I recently made a payment on April 8, 2013 in the amount of \$ 309.70 and plan to make another \$300.00 dollar payment in the next few days.

I have been able to work out payment plans with my water, gas and mortgage bills. Duquesne Light is the only one who will not work something out for me.

Enclosed are copies of the documents (Exhibits 1 and 2) that I intended to offer into evidence at the hearing in the above referenced matter that was scheduled for Friday, January 18, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.





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
