Dear Mr. Habjan:

The Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement (I&E) files this petition for leave to withdraw the complaint in the above-captioned case pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.94.

On July 26, 2012, I&E served a complaint alleging that your utility violated Section 510(c) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §510(c), for failing to pay the Commission's assessment for the 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 fiscal years. The complaint also alleged that your utility violated Section 510(b) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §510(b), for failing to file assessment reports for the 2007 and 2008 calendar years. In the complaint, I&E requested that your utility pay its outstanding assessment balance of \$1,234 and a civil penalty of \$2,185.

No response was received to the complaint. On January 2, 2013, I&E filed a motion for default judgment. Thereafter, on January 23, 2013, Pine Roe Natural Gas Company, Inc. paid its outstanding assessment of \$1,234.

Due to the fact that Pine Roe Natural Gas Company, Inc. satisfied the assessment amount that it owed, I&E is willing to waive the civil penalty for this time only and withdraw its complaint. I&E will pursue a civil penalty if Pine Roe Natural Gas Company, Inc. fails to timely pay its assessment in the future.

For the above-referenced reason, I&E requests that the complaint in the above-captioned matter be withdrawn.

If no party objects within 20 days of service of this letter, this case should be marked closed.
