- 3. <u>History of the Proceeding</u>: On or about March 18, 2013, Peoples Natural Gas Company, LLC; Peoples TWP, LLC (hereinafter referred to together as "Peoples"); and Equitable filed a joint application ("Application") with the Commission seeking approval for the proposed merger of Equitable, with and into Peoples, as well as related transactions, as set forth in the Application.
