Gentlemen:

This is to advise you that on or about February 3, 1988, a certain motor vehicle, herein identified as a Kenworth truck, bearing Pennsylvania License No. AA67888, Identification No. 212939, further identified as Company No. 384, leased to you by James M. Workman, Jr., 514 Weidman Street, Lebanon, Pennsylvania, was checked by Bernard Carnes, a duly authorized enforcement officer of this Commission, at or near Route No. 72, Rapno Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and the following deficiencies were observed:

It was found that the said motor vehicle combination failed to display your proper name and address on the sides of the power unit, as required by the Commission's Motor Carrier Property Transportation Regulation, 52 Pa. Code §31.33(b).

52 Pa. Code §31.33(b) states:

"Each motor carrier shall cause to be painted on each side of every motor vehicle operated by him, in letters not less than two inches in height, and not less than 1/2 inch in width, the name and address of such motor carrier and the number of the certificate of public convenience or permit as follows: 'PA P.U.C. NO. A. _____'. If the vehicle is owned by someone other than the motor carrier operating it, there shall be shown on each side of the vehicle, in letters not less than two inches in height and not less than 1/2 inch in width, the wording: 'OPERATED BY (name and address of authorized motor carrier), PA P.U.C. NO. A. _____'. If a removable device is used to identify the operating carrier as lessee, such device shall be of durable material and securely affixed, to the vehicle operated, throughout the duration of the lease."

The power unit was marked "Trans American."

In addition, there was no copy of a proper written lease or lease card on board. This is a violation of the Commission's Motor Carrier Property Transportation Regulation, 52 Pa. Code §31.32(c)(2)(vii).

52 Pa. Code §31.32(c)(2)(vii) states:

"Leases shall be executed in triplicate. The original shall be retained by the motor carrier in whose service the equipment is to be operated, one copy shall be retained by the owner of the equipment and one copy shall be carried on the equipment specified therein during the entire period of the contract, lease, or other arrangement, unless a certificate is carried on the equipment in lieu thereof, certifying that the equipment is being operated by it, the name of the owner, the date of the lease, contract, or other arrangement, the period thereof, and the location where the original of the lease, contract, or other arrangement is retained by the motor carrier."

The lease on board was between James M. Workman, Jr. and Falcon Transport, Inc.

In light of the above, you are hereby directed to comply with the aforesaid regulation within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this letter and submit proof of compliance to this office forthwith. Failure to comply may subject you to the penalties as may be imposed by this Commission for violation of its regulations.
