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**ERRATA SHEET**

**JOINT SETTLEMENT OF ALL ISSUES OF THE  
RATE INVESTIGATION PURSUANT TO 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f)**

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TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES  
JEFFREY WATSON AND CONRAD A. JOHNSON:

Peoples TWP LLC (“Peoples TWP” or the “Company”) herein files this Errata Sheet to correct the effective date of the Retainage Rate set forth in Joint Petition for Settlement of All Issues of the Rate Investigation Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f) (“Settlement”). For the reasons explained below, Peoples TWP respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judges Jeffrey Watson and Conrad A. Johnson and the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) accept this Errata Sheet into the record and modify the Settlement consistent herewith. In support, Peoples TWP states as follows:

On April 26, 2013, the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), and Peoples TWP, parties to the above-captioned proceeding (hereinafter, collectively referred to as the “Settling Parties”), filed the together with Statements in Support. Therein, the Settling

Parties respectfully requested that: (1) the ALJs approve the Settlement to become effective for service furnished on and after August 1, 2013; and (2) the ALJs and the Commission make the findings required by the Public Utility Code.

In Section II, the Settlement provides as follows:

21. Retainage Rate. **Effective July 1, 2013**, the tariffed retainage rate for Small Volume transportation customers (Rate Schedules RS-T, GSS-T, GSL-T) shall be reduced from 6.3% to 5.4%, and the tariffed retainage rate for Large Volume transportation customers (Rate Schedules LGS-T, SLGS-T, LGS-T, EPGS-T, FTS) shall be reduced from 4.0% to 3.4%. In deriving the foregoing retainage percentages, a three-year average of Lost and Unaccounted for Gas ("LUFG") and Company Use Gas was used.

See Settlement, Section II, page 4, ¶ 21.

The effective date for the settled Retainage Rate set forth in Paragraph 21 of the Settlement is in error. As set forth in Settlement, the Settling Parties are requesting that the ALJs and Commission approve the Settlement to become effective for service furnished **on and after August 1, 2013**. Accordingly, Paragraph 21 of the Settlement must be corrected to provide as follows:


21. Retainage Rate. ~~Effective July 1, 2013~~ **August 1, 2013**, the tariffed retainage rate for Small Volume transportation customers (Rate Schedules RS-T, GSS-T, GSL-T) shall be reduced from 6.3% to 5.4%, and the tariffed retainage rate for Large Volume transportation customers (Rate Schedules LGS-T, SLGS-T, LGS-T, EPGS-T, FTS) shall be reduced from 4.0% to 3.4%. In deriving the foregoing retainage percentages, a three-year average of Lost and Unaccounted for Gas ("LUFG") and Company Use Gas was used.

Peoples TWP has contacted counsel for I&E, OCA, and the OSBA and is authorized to represent that the Settling Parties have no objection to and fully agree with the above-described correction to the Settlement. Peoples TWP therefore respectfully requests, on behalf of the

Settling Parties, that Paragraph 21 of the Settlement be corrected for purposes of the record as described herein.

WHEREFORE, Peoples TWP LLC respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judges Jeffrey Watson and Conrad A. Johnson and the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission accept this Errata Sheet into the record, modify the "Joint Petition for Settlement of All Issues of the Rate Investigation Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f)" consistent herewith, and approve the "Joint Petition for Settlement of All Issues of the Rate Investigation Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f)" for the reasons stated in Statements in Support submitted by the Settling Parties.

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
