
For calendar year Adam Meyer, Inc. generated total revenues of \$432,537 and expenses of \$407,272, or an operating ratio of 94.1%. Of that total revenues \$187,110 applied to the transportation of household goods in use.

Also attached is a Wage Cost Study Form prepared by Adam Meyer, Inc. which reflects an increase in wages and fringe benefits of from 2011 to 2013 of 2.1%

The proposed increase in hourly rates is 3.2%.

The proposed loose-leaf revision to Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 has been filed on sixty (60) day's notice with a tentative effective date of July 15, 2013 unless further suspended.
