On August 9, 2012, as amended on August 28, 2012, you filed on behalf of AP&G Holdings LLC (AP&G) an application for market-based rate authority with an accompanying tariff. The proposed market-based rate tariff provides for the sale of energy, capacity, and ancillary services at market-based rates. AP&G requests waivers commonly granted to similar market-based rate applicants.

Your filings were noticed on August 10, 2012 and August 28, 2012, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before August 30, 2012 and September 18, 2012, respectively. None was filed.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittals filed in the referenced dockets are accepted for filing, effective October 12, 2012, as requested. Based on your

representations, AP&G meets the criteria for a Category 1 seller in all regions and is so designated.²

You state that AP&G is located in Dunedin, Florida, and intends to act as a power marketer. You further represent that AP&G is wholly owned by Consumer Sales Solutions, LLC and five individuals and is not affiliated with any entity that owns or controls generation or transmission facilities. Further, you affirmatively state that AP&G has not erected barriers to entry and will not erect barriers to entry into the relevant market.

Your state that AP&G meets the criteria for Category 1 status because it and its affiliates do not own or control in excess of 500 MW in any region; it and its affiliates do not own or control any transmission facilities; it and its affiliates are not affiliated with any franchised public utility; and it and its affiliates do not present any other vertical market concerns.

Market-Based Rate Authorization

The Commission allows power sales at market-based rates if the seller and its affiliates do not have, or have adequately mitigated, horizontal and vertical market power.³

Based on your representations, AP&G's submittal satisfies the Commission's requirements for market-based rate authority regarding horizontal and vertical market power.

AP&G requests blanket authorization under Part 34 of the Commission's regulations for all future issuances of securities and assumptions of liability. A separate notice was published in the Federal Register establishing a period during which protests could be filed. None was filed. AP&G is authorized to issue securities and assume obligations or liabilities as guarantor, indorser, surety, or otherwise in respect of any

1. Background. This is an Agreement between I, the "Customer" and American Power & Gas of Pennsylvania, LLC ("AP&G"), to supply my home with all the natural gas I need subject to the eligibility requirements of my natural gas distribution company ("NGDC"), and acceptance by AP&G ("Agreement"). The Public Utility Commission of Pennsylvania ("PUC") has authorized AP&G to act as a Natural Gas Supplier and has entered into a service agreement with the NGDC. AP&G is a retail energy marketer and not my NGDC. The PUC does not regulate the price of natural gas or other charges found in this Agreement. I am at least 18 years old and fully authorized to enter into this Agreement. AP&G sets the generation prices and charges that you pay. The PUC regulates distribution prices and services. The Federal Regulatory Commission regulates transmission prices and services. You will receive a single bill from your NGDC for both its charges and AP&G's charges. I may rescind this Agreement without fees or penalties within three (3) business days of receipt of this disclosure, by contacting AP&G in writing, at 411 Cleveland Street #299, Clearwater, FL 33755, or by telephone at (800) 205-7491.

2. Definitions.

Interstate Pipeline Charges. Charges for moving natural gas to the distribution lines of a distribution company.

Distribution Charges. The utility charges for the delivery of natural gas from the city gate to the consumer.

- 3. Term. This Agreement shall commence as of the date the change of Customer's provider to AP&G is deemed effective by the NGDC, and shall continue for 24 months thereafter (the "Initial Term"). Unless otherwise agreed to, upon completion of the Initial Term, this Agreement will renew to a new 24month term. Either party may cancel or terminate this Agreement by providing 30 (thirty) days' advance written notice of termination to the other party.
- 4. Pricing, Billing, and Termination. The price for all natural gas sold under this Agreement shall be a variable price which each month shall reflect the wholesale cost of natural gas (including commodity, capacity, storage and balancing), transportation to the Delivery Point, and other market-related factors, plus all applicable taxes, fees, charges or other assessments and AP&G's costs, expenses and margins.
- 5. Information. For inquiries and information regarding natural gas suppliers and the competitive retail natural gas market, I can contact the PUC at (888)
- 6. Emergency Service. In an emergency, I should immediately call Colombia Gas of Pennsylvania at (888) 460-4332 or National Fuel at (866)-252-4636 and local emergency personnel. If I experience service related problems, I should contact my utility.
- 7. Dispute Resolution. If I have a question or concern about my bill, I may contact AP&G in writing at 411 Cleveland Street #299, Clearwater, FL 33755, or by telephone at (800) 205-7491. AP&G will refer all complaints to a representative in their customer service center who, in good faith, will use reasonable efforts to reach a mutually satisfactory solution. If I am still not satisfied, I may call the PUC toll free at (800) 782-1110, or write the PUC, Bureau of Consumer Services, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.
- 8. Cancellation Procedures. Either party may cancel this Agreement (for reasons other than non-payment) at any time by providing written notice to AP&G, at 411 Cleveland Street #299, Clearwater, FL 33755, or to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of the intended month of cancellation. If I fail to notify AP&G as set forth above, I shall remain liable to pay AP&G for any natural gas acquisitions made by AP&G to serve me under this Agreement at the price set forth above. It may take up to sixty (60) days after cancellation before I can receive supply from the NGDC, or other natural gas supplier, depending upon the NGDC, or other supplier procedures. During this time, I agree to pay for all natural gas I consume that AP&G supplies to me. I will be issued a final bill within twenty (20) days after the final scheduled meter reading, or if meter access is restricted, an estimate of consumption will be used to calculate such bill, which will be reconciled after the final meter reading. Customer may cancel this Agreement without penalty in the event Customer relocates from one location to another, even if the move is within an NGDC's service territory. If your natural gas service is terminated by your NGDC, then this Agreement is cancelled on the date that your natural gas service is terminated.
- 9. Natural Gas Supply Quantity. The NGDC will determine all natural gas quantities supplied under this Agreement, including storage, and all such amounts will be accepted as accurate and conclusive by both parties and shall constitute the amount of the sale.
- 10. Agency & Power of Attorney. I appoint AP&G as my agent and grant AP&G a power of attorney to act on my behalf in acquiring the supplies necessary to meet my natural gas needs, contracting for and administering transportation, transmission and related services over interstate facilities and any NGDC services necessary to deliver natural gas to my premises. AP&G provides these services to me at no additional charge, as they are already included in the price noted above.
- 11. Invoicing and Payment. Unless otherwise agreed to in writing, the NGDC will invoice me monthly for natural gas supplied to me under this Agreement.
- 12. Title. All natural gas sold under this Agreement shall be delivered to a location considered the "Point of Delivery," which shall be a location determined by AP&G, and shall constitute the point at which, upon delivery thereto, the sale occurs and title passes from AP&G to me.
- 13. Liability. The remedy in any claim or suit by Customer against AP&G will be solely limited to direct actual damages (which will not exceed the amount of Customer's single largest monthly invoice amount in the immediately preceding 12 months). All other remedies at law or in equity are hereby waived. In

no event will either AP&G or Customer be liable for consequential, incidental, indirect, special or punitive damages. These limitations apply without regard to the cause of any liability or damages. There are no third-party beneficiaries to this Agreement.

- 14. Choice of Laws. Venue for any lawsuit brought to enforce any term or condition of this Agreement, or to construe the terms hereof shall be exclusively in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. This Agreement shall be construed under and shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 15. Assignment. I may not assign my interest in any obligations under this Agreement without the express advance written consent of AP&G. AP&G may sell, transfer, pledge, or assign the accounts, revenues, or proceeds hereof, in connection with any financial agreement and may assign this Agreement to another natural gas supplier, natural gas services company, or other entity in accordance with the PUC rules and procedures, if any, governing such transactions.
- 16. Severance. If a court or regulatory agency of competent jurisdiction deems any provision of this Agreement to be invalid, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force without being invalidated in any way.
- 17. No Warranties. Unless otherwise expressly set forth in this Agreement, AP&G provides and I shall receive no warranties, express, or implied, statutory, or otherwise and AP&G specifically disclaims any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.
- 18. Delay or Failure to Exercise Rights. No partial performance, delay or failure on the part of AP&G in exercising any rights under this Agreement and no partial or single exercise thereof shall constitute a waiver of such rights or of any other rights hereunder.
- 19. Force Majeure and Other Circumstances. AP&G will make commercially reasonable efforts to provide natural gas hereunder but AP&G does not guarantee a continuous supply of natural gas to Customer. Certain causes and events out of the control of AP&G ("Force Majeure Events") may result in interruptions in service. AP&G will not be liable for any such interruptions caused by a Force Majeure Event, and AP&G is not and shall not be liable for damages caused by Force Majeure Events. Force Majeure Events shall include acts of God, fire, flood, storm, terrorism, war, civil disturbance, acts of any governmental authority, accidents, strikes, labor disputes or problems, required maintenance work, inability to access the local distribution utility system, non-performance by the NGDC (including, but not limited to, a facility outage on its gas distribution lines), changes in laws, rules, or regulations of any governmental authority or any other cause beyond AP&G's control.

Except as provided in this Agreement or by law, all taxes, levies, assessments and fees of whatsoever kind, nature and description, due and payable with respect to the delivery of natural gas under this Agreement, shall be paid or reimbursed by me except for federal, state or local taxes imposed on the net taxable income of AP&G. The parties' obligations under this Agreement are subject to present and future legislation, orders, rules, or regulations of a duly constituted governmental authority having competent jurisdiction.
- 21. Entire Agreement. This Agreement and the Enrollment Confirmation set forth the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the terms and conditions of this transaction; any and all other agreements, understandings and representations by and between the parties with respect to the matters addressed herein and therein are superseded by this Agreement and the Enrollment Confirmation.
