

**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM
OF INTERSTATE GAS SUPPLY, INC.**

NOW COMES Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (“IGS”) and hereby respectfully provides this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Cynthia Williams Fordham’s Prehearing Conference Order issued May 16, 2013. At the outset, it is important to note that IGS intends to take a monitoring roll, at least initially, in this proceeding and will actively participate only if substantial deviation from the proposal is likely. In compliance with the ALJ’s Order, IGS offers the following:

I. SCHEDULE

1. PECO Energy Company (“PECO”) has proposed a fairly aggressive schedule for litigation in this matter that includes shortening the response times for discovery. IGS offers no opinion on the schedule at this time and will accept PECO’s schedule as proposed.

II. DISCOVERY

2. IGS does not presently plan to conduct discovery, but if it does, it agrees with the condensed schedule for discovery proposed earlier in this same docket.

III. ISSUES

3. From IGS' prospective, the primary issue in this case is whether PECO's proposal to allow CAP customers to shop, including the cost recovery proposal, is fair to customers, to EGSs, and to the company, and whether it is otherwise just and reasonable.

IV. WITNESS

4. IGS does not presently intend to call a witness, but reserves the right to call a witness in the rebuttal or surrebuttal phases of this proceeding, if it becomes necessary based upon the direction this proceeding may take in testimony or otherwise. IGS will provide notice of any such witness as soon as may be practical under the circumstances.

V. SETTLEMENT


5. IGS believes that this proceeding is susceptible to settlement and agrees to participate in good faith in any settlement negotiations that may be had.

VI. OTHER PROCEDURAL ISSUES

6. IGS agrees to accept service by electronic mail and with hard copy to be followed the next day it by first-class mail.
