We recently received a complaint filed by the PA PUC indicating that we failed to maintain evidence of insurance on file with the Commission. The Master's Trucking LLC has not been active and has had no IFTA miles recorded since November 2012.

We moved from Pennsylvania to Washington state, with the intention of continuing the business, however, the contract that we had been working on, fell through and due to the differences in state requirements we were unable to continue without purchasing a newer vehicle, which was not an option for us. We maintained the insurance for the full time period because we had hopes of returning to PA for a 3 month job in the spring of 2013. In order to secure the job, we would have had to extend our insurance for three months only and the insurance company would not do a month to month. We would have had to pay for the entire year, which was not an option for us financially. So, we did not work in Pennsylvania after November 2012.

Insurance was not maintained after March 25, 2013 because the truck/vehicle was not running. The last time it was driven was November 2012.

The family moved from Pennsylvania to Washington state on November 20, 2012. No business was procured and the truck was not driven for hire while in the state of Washington.

Due to our circumstances with having to close down the business, we are requesting that the Commission waive the \$500 penalty. Thank you in advance for your consideration.
