ORDER #2 GRANTING INTERVENTION

Subsequent to the issuance of Prehearing Order #1 on April 25, 1997, and Intervention Order #1 on May 5, 1997, several Motions to Intervene have been filed. These pleadings are addressed in this Order.

On April 30, 1997, the Department of the Navy filed a Motion to Intervene in this proceeding. No objection was raised to this request.
