ORDER #4 GRANTING INTERVENTION

On June 4, 1997, a Motion to Intervene was filed by the Delaware Valley Schools Energy/Utility Consortium (DVSEUC), which consists of "approximately 70 school districts in the Montgomery, Delaware, Bucks and Chester County areas." No objection was raised to this request. Therefore, the Petition is granted and, pursuant to the request contained in that Petition, DVSEUC is to be considered an active party in this proceeding and should be added to the active party service list.

Also on June 4, 1997, a Petition to Intervene was filed by Ethan Giddings, an individual customer. No objection was raised to this request. Therefore, this Petition also is granted. As Mr. Giddings did not indicate that he wished active party status, he should be placed on the inactive party service list.

Also on June 4, 1997, intervenor Pennsylvania Petroleum Association filed a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice on behalf of Usher Fogel, Esq. This Motion is granted.

As set out in Prehearing Order #1, active parties will receive all documents and must copy all other active parties on documents they send to the Commission or the presiding officers. They are expected to attend hearings, present witnesses and conduct discovery and cross-examination. Inactive parties will receive only hearing notices, the recommended decision, and the Commission order. They may participate and give testimony at public input hearings which will be held at various locations in PECO's service territory.
