
Pursuant to 66 Pa. C. S. §2808(f), the provisions of the settlement of your restructuring proceeding at R-973953 and P-971265, and our tentative and final orders at D-98S042, you are obligated to file a reconciliation statement for review of annual CTC/ITC revenues pursuant to the provisions of 66 Pa.C.S. §1307(e) on August 30, 1999. You are also required to provide such customer notice as the Commission shall direct, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §53.45(g).

Upon consideration of your request for guidance as to the appropriate form of customer notice, you are directed to provide the following notice to customers:

- All participants in the restructuring proceeding at R-973953 and P-971265 shall be served with a copy of the filing at the same time as it is served upon the Commission. KJR
- Include in your reconciliation filing a draft form of notice of the filing suitable for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin consistent with the provisions of 1 Pa. Code §11.1, et seq.
- After the Commission has issued a final order with respect to your filing which approves CTC/ITC tariffs for calendar year 2000, notify all customers of such tariff changes by bill insert notice as promptly as practicable. The bill insert shall contain, at a minimum, information describing any adjustment, the effect of such changes on a typical residential, commercial and industrial customer's bill, the effect on the shopping credit, if any, and a statement that customers may contact you at a given telephone number to get further information on the adjustment.
