**PECO ENERGY COMPANY'S MOTION
TO ADMIT EXHIBITS INTO THE RECORD**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero's Order, dated July 3, 2013, hereby motions to admit PECO Energy's exhibits 1-11 into the record and states the following:

1. On March 15, 2013, an in-person hearing was convened in the above-referenced matter.
2. At the hearing, PECO Energy presented Regulatory Assessor, Dana McCollum, as a witness on behalf of the company.
3. Ms. McCollum identified, authenticated and testified to eleven (11) exhibits offered on behalf of PECO Energy.
4. The Complainant did not prepare or offer any exhibits into the record and offered solely her testimony to support her burden of proof.
5. After the Complainant and PECO Energy had put on their cases, the Complainant claimed that she could present her landlord as a witness to refute some of the testimony and/or exhibits presented by PECO Energy.
6. Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero ("ALJ Vero") permitted the Complainant to have an additional hearing date to present the testimony of her landlord.

7. ALJ Vero advised the parties there would be additional testimony at the further hearing from the Complainant's landlord and any exhibits could be entered into the record at that time.

8. On March 21, 2013, the Complainant notified ALJ Vero that her landlord was not available to testify at a further hearing.

9. Accordingly, no further hearing was scheduled for this matter, as the sole purpose of another hearing was so that the Complainant could bring additional evidence in the form of her landlord's testimony.

10. As there was no further hearing, PECO Energy did not have an opportunity to admit its exhibits into the record.

11. On July 3, 2013, ALJ Vero issued an Order, permitting PECO Energy to file a written motion, offering PECO Energy's proposed Exhibits 1-11 into the record.

12. PECO Energy now motions this Honorable Commission to admit PECO Energy Exhibits 1-11 into the record.

WHEREFORE, PECO Energy respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission grant Respondent, PECO Energy's Motion to Admit Exhibits 1-11 into the Record.
