TO THE COMMISSION:

1. The Applicant is Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority ("SEPTA"), with its principle address at 1234 Market Street, 10th Floor, Philadelphia, PA 19107-3780
2. The applicant's attorney is Joseph J. Devanney, SEPTA Legal Division, 1234 Market Street, 5th Floor, Philadelphia, Pa 19107-3780.
3. SEPTA is a body corporate and politic which exercises the public powers of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as an agency and instrumentality thereof.
4. SEPTA herein seeks the approval of the Public Utility Commission ("Commission"), to install a new pedestrian at-grade crossing, near to where Red Lion Road crosses the SEPTA West Trenton Branch tracks, AAR# 589-938-S, in the Township of Lower Moreland, Montgomery County, PA, as further shown in the three pages of attached drawings/plans designated collectively as "Attachment A".
5. The attached service list has parties which, to the information and belief of SEPTA, may have an interest in the subject matter of this application.
6. This work will be performed by SEPTA and funded through a PADOT Grant. SEPTA at present values the work at \$200,000.00, with an appropriate contingency for unexpected costs.
7. The construction is necessary to create a safe pedestrian access route across the tracks and along Red Lion Road. This crossing will connect the existing sidewalks, parallel to Red Lion Road, that presently terminate on either side of the tracks of the West Trenton Right-Of-Way. Maintenance will be divided between SEPTA and Lower Moreland Township.

WHEREFORE, Applicant SEPTA respectfully requests Your Honorable Commission to approve of said Application as promptly as possible.
