





- If successful, we will be compensated for our services and this compensation
 will be defined and transparent. Business decisions focus on several parts,
 significant among these is what are you paying and what are you getting for
 your money. We encourage you to ask the question, "How are you paid for
 your services and what is IPP's margin?"
- The power procurement process may be accomplished by negotiating directly with providers or having someone do this on your behalf. Either process includes a cost. The cost should not be cumulative, meaning that the provider will charge different prices depending on how a client is acquired. The analogy often used is how do you buy your different types of insurance? Most likely you use a broker who understands your needs, knows the market, has good relations with providers, and presents you with an appropriate list of suitable alternatives. They are a smart, cost-efficient outsource. Energy consultants/brokers should meet similar criteria and scope in when it comes to your energy procurement.
- Retail Electric Providers (REPs) will price your facility either directly (only able to provide quotes from the one REP who employees them) or through a consultant/broker (also known as third party channel who are able to provide quotes from multiple REPs). REPS will only price one way or the other. If there is no direct pricing, then the first consultant/broker to request pricing (first come/first serve) or the current consultant/broker of record (that negotiated the current/existing agreement) will be the default answer as to who receives quotes. You have the ultimate say as to whom you work with, but, should you want to use someone who is otherwise blocked from pricing, you will have to declare your intentions some way or another. It might be a formal "Letter of Exclusivity" that states what your intention is or it may be as simple as an email to a particular REP or a general "To Whom It May Concern."

The key is what you want to do. There have been instances where some less than scrupulous players have disguised an LOE as something else. We always recommend that customers read what you're signing.

- It is much easier to go through the process with complete and accurate
 information from the beginning. IPP will take the time to insure that you are
 pricing what you intend to price. Check bills, internal excel sheets with site
 specific information, and any other "fail safe" with the list of ESIs itemized on
 the LOA form you signed to request usage data from the TDSP (the utility
 responsible for delivery of power to your site(s)).
- There are no such things as bad questions: When in doubt, always ask.
- Consultants and brokers have been used interchangeably in this discussion just as they are in the industry at large. We distinguish the two labels as follows:
 - Consultants Entities who provide advice and perform the outsourced function of energy procurement and risk management for a fee/margin. They are engaged throughout the term of procurement and "have your back" in regards to alerting you to opportunities and adversities should they appear. They should be vetted for experience and expertise.
 - Brokers Salesmen. They match buyers (you) with sellers (REPs) for a fee/margin. They are more likely transaction-oriented and not engaged for a continuing advisory relationship.
- Regardless of which route you've elected for pricing, please note that if you
 don't trust the person you're dealing with, you don't have to use them.



















Commercial Credit Score Class










Factors Related to Risk of Payment Delinquency





Our agency has issued the enclosed certificate of insurance on behalf of our client. We want to share with you some important information regarding certificates of insurance.

The Texas Legislature passed and Governor Perry signed Senate Bill 425 to become effective January 1, 2012. After this date it will be illegal for an agent or insurance company to issue evidence of insurance on a certificate form that has not been approved by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI). It is also illegal for anyone to require an agent or insurance company to use a certificate form that has not been approved by the State.

The law provides some guidance on the content and limitations of certificates, as follows:

- A certificate is not an insurance policy and does not amend, extend, or alter the coverage afforded by the referenced insurance policy.

- The law confirms that "a certificate of insurance that is executed, issued, or required and that is in violation with this chapter is void and has no effect."



- I. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") grants a license to Infinity Power Partners, LLC ("IPP" or "Applicant") to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia. Specifically, IPP intends to operate as a broker of electricity for commercial and industrial customers in the District of Columbia, pursuant to Section 34-1505 of the "Retail Electric Competition and Consumer Protection Act of 1999 ("Act")."
- 2. On March 20, 2013, IPP filed its license application.³ Pursuant to the Commission's licensing requirements as set forth in Order No. 11796,⁴ IPP has provided the following information:
 - a) Proof of technical and managerial competence;
 - b) An affidavit of compliance with applicable Federal and District of Columbia environmental laws and regulations dated February 6, 2013;
 - c) Proof of financial integrity to include financial statements;
 - d) Proof that IPP has registered with the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to do business in the District of Columbia;
 - e) An affidavit that IPP is subject to all applicable taxes;
 - f) An affidavit dated February 6, 2013, stating that IPP will comply with all the requirements of all orders and regulations of the Commission; and

D.C. Official Code § 34-1501(17) (2010 Repl.) defines, in part, an electricity supplier as "a person, including an aggregator, broker, or marketer, who generates electricity; sells electricity; or purchases, brokers, arranges or markets electricity for sale to customers."


