Dear Mr. Russell:

The Commission, at its December 16, 1999 public meeting, took the following actions regarding PP&L, Inc. (PP&L):

- 1) Adopted an order at Docket Nos. R-00994965, P-00991780 and R-00994965C001 approving PP&L's Petition for permission to defer, for future recovery, a portion of its calendar year 2000 Competitive Transition Charge and approving PP&L's calculation of its State Tax Adjustment Surcharge.
- 2) Issued a Secretarial Letter at Docket Nos. R-00973954/M-FACE9908 accepting PP&L's Competitive Transition Charge reconciliation statement for the year ended December 31, 1999, subject to public hearing to be held pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(e).
- 3) Issued a Secretarial Letter at Docket No. R-00994875 approving PP&L's calculation of its Intangible Transition Charge under-recoveries for the period August through November 30, 1999; approved PP&L's revised sales forecast for calendar year 2000 and its revised forecast of transition bond expenses.


PP&L was directed to file, within three days of December 16, 1999, a tariff supplement implementing these Commission approvals.

On December 20, 1999, PP&L filed Supplement No. 8 to Tariff-Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 in compliance with the Commission's Order and Secretarial Letters described above. Supplement No. 8 sets forth revised Intangible Transition Charges, Competitive Transition Charges and State Tax Adjustment Surcharge, to be effective January 1, 2000.

We have reviewed PP&L's Supplement No. 8 and conclude that it properly implements the Commission's December 16, 1999 Order and Secretarial Letters. Accordingly, Supplement No. 8 is accepted by the Commission, and the rates set forth therein are approved to be effective January 1, 2000.
