2. The response to Question 8 is hereby amended to remove the Applicant's desire to be registered as a Broker. Pursuant to the Final Order in Docket L-2011-2266832, Applicant understands that the Commission changed the definition of Aggregator to only apply to entities which will take title to natural gas. Applicant does not intend to take title to natural gas and therefore withdraws its application to the extent that any information to become an Aggregator and wishes only to be licensed as a Broker.

4. Appendix B—contains a copy of letters from each local gas distribution company stating that EMEX does not need to post a bond with the individual local gas distribution companies;

Dear Mr. Golden:

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("NFGDC") is aware that Energy Market Exchange, LLC. ("EMEX") has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the service territory of NFGDC.

As you know, in making such an application, EMEX must furnish acceptable security to each utility where EMEX will do business. As such, under its tariff, NFGDC could require EMEX to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that NFGDC determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is NFGDC's understanding that EMEX intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that, in performing these services, EMEX will never take title to any delivered natural gas.

Based upon your representations, NFGDC has determined that, at this time, EMEX does not need to post a bond or other form of security to operate in its service territory. However, if the services provided by EMEX change in the future, NFGDC reserves the right to require security from EMEX as it deems appropriate.

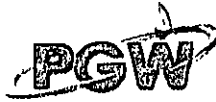

However, if in the future your company desires to establish a Non-Priority One Pool or a Priority One Pool on the Peoples Natural Gas Company system, it may be required to establish a security or credit enhancement based on the terms set forth under Paragraphs 6 and 7 of the Rules and Regulations of The Peoples Natural Gas Company Supplier Tariff.



This is based on the declaration that EMEX will not be taking title to gas or directly serving end use customers. This also assumes that EMEX will be acting on the behalf of a licensed Natural Gas Supplier who has been approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to serve in the applicable UGI service territories and who has posted the required financial security as specified in the respective UGI tariffs. 
