

This is in response to docket no. C-2013-2370858. We recently changed insurance carriers effective 5/28/2013. Our previous carrier was Erie Insurance, our current carrier is Grange Insurance. We are a towing company that tows and recovers vehicles. We carry on hook cargo insurance. Our new policy was effective 5/28/2013. We were notified that our current carrier failed to notify PUC of the new insurance. We called the insurance agency and they supposedly straightened it out. Upon receiving the complaint in question, I called our agency and faxed them a copy of the complaint. They said they would check into it. The agency failed to notify me that it was or was not taken care of. I called Wendy at PUC and explained to her the situation. She informed me that she needs the H form sent to PUC. I again called our insurance agency and told them we needed an H form. Gloria at our insurance agency informed me that she will check into it. She said that since we are a towing facility she can't understand why we need a separate cargo policy. I'm still waiting to hear back from her. I would ask that if our on hook cargo coverage is sufficient that this fine could be waived.

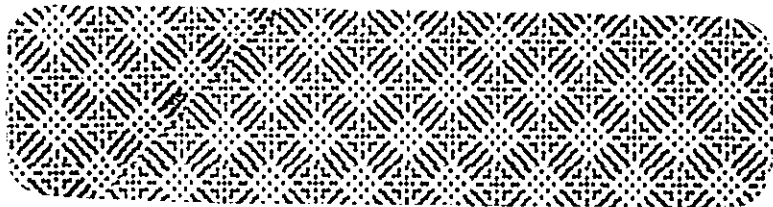
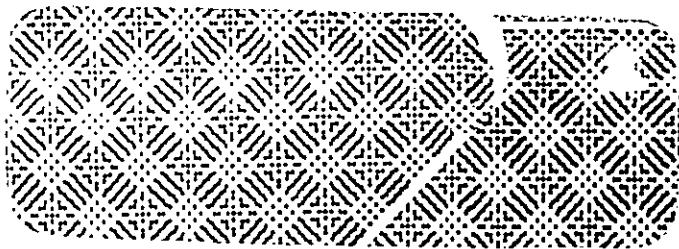
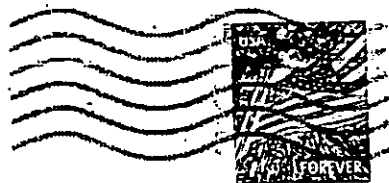
