
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I reviewed PGW's response of July 11 with the owners of the property. He now understands that PGW "noticed" the tenant of an improper service hook-up, however, this did not involve the owners' permission to use gas, nor do they recall any notice to them. Only after seven years was a request for payment sent to them after their title search.

Under such circumstances wherein a tenant was allowed a \$13,000 usage to accrue without notice to the owners, with a billing to the owners only after requested by a refinancing title search, it would seem unconscionable to require the owners to be responsible for the payment.

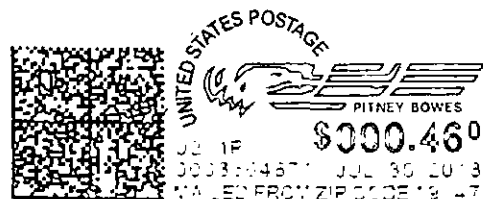
