

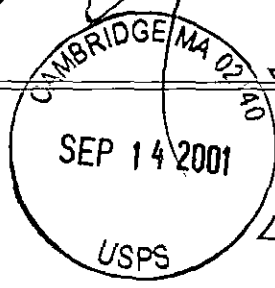

4. That Philadelphia Gas Works shall comply with all of the terms and conditions contained in the Joint Petition.




