


PETITION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT

Upper Allen Township Fire Department (“Fire Department”), by and through its counsel, Nauman, Smith, Shissler & Hall, LLP, hereby files this Petition for Leave to Withdraw its Complaint filed against United Water Pennsylvania, Inc. (“United Water”), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a), based upon the following:

1. Fire Department filed a Complaint against United Water on May 5, 2013, for the elimination or reduction of what it views as an “exorbitant” monthly fire protection fee charged by United Water for the sprinkler system installed in Fire Department’s station.
2. United Water filed its Answer on May 15, 2013.
3. An initial telephonic hearing was held on August 6, 2013, before Administrative Law Judge Joel Cheskis, at which Fire Department stated its intention to withdraw its Complaint.
4. Fire Department hereby seeks leave to withdraw its Complaint, as it has decided not to pursue its objection to the amount of the monthly fire protection fee in this matter at this time.

WHEREFORE, Upper Allen Township Fire Department respectfully requests that its Petition for Leave to Withdraw its Complaint in the above matter be granted.


