Dennis Sakelson's Motion For Continuance of Hearing Date

Dennis Sakelson, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Section 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter for August 29, 2013 and states the following:

1. Plaintiff, Dennis Sakelson, requests that the initial hearing scheduled in the above captioned matter for August 29, 2013 be continued for the reasons set forth in this Motion.
2. Dennis Sakelson and PECO Energy have been in settlement discussions. Dennis Sakelson asserts that a bill from a prior owner and then a tenant should not be transferred to his account.
3. Based on the discussions, it is Dennis Sakelson's belief that he meets the requirements of PECO Energy's Customer Assistance Program ("CAP") and he has filed the application with PECO Energy and emailed a copy of his application to PECO Energy's attorney on August 23, 2013.
4. If Dennis Sakelson's CAP application is accepted, Dennis Sakelson will withdraw his complaint and/or notify the PUC that the matter is settled, in accordance to the PUC's rules and regulations.
5. Further, based on the parties' settlement discussions, Dennis Sakelson has also offered to settle the matter in the event his CAP application is denied by making payments towards an amount that the parties still need to agree upon. However, Dennis Sakelson is able to pay the

initial payment that PECO Energy requires for such a settlement and he believes, based on the parties' discussions, that a settlement figure will likely be agreed to.

6. Dennis Sakelson will also provide documentation to PECO Energy, such as the date the deed was transferred from the prior owner and the date the prior owner (who stayed in the property and became a tenant) vacated the premises. These documents will help the parties to settle the matter.

7. PECO Energy's counsel does not object to Dennis Sakelson's request for a continuance of the August 29, 2013 hearing.

8. Dennis Sakelson wishes to avoid the expense and time of a hearing and put his energy and available finances to settling the matter.

WHEREFORE, Dennis Sakelson respectfully requests that your Honor grant his Motion for a Continuance of the August 29, 2013 hearing.
