Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Philadelphia Gas Works, the Respondent (PGW) hereby requests a continuance of the hearing in this matter scheduled for Wednesday, September 4, 2013. In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:

1. On March 8, 2013, the Commission served the Respondent with the Complaint filed in the above captioned matter, which is a billing dispute concerning a bill for previously unbilled service.
2. On March 27, 2013, PGW filed an Answer to the Complaint in the above captioned matter.
3. By Notice dated April 1, 2013, the Commission scheduled an In Person Hearing in this matter for Friday, June 21, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Angela T. Jones, in the Commission's Philadelphia office.
4. Mr. Evanson arrived late for the hearing on June 21, 2013, but the Commission scheduled another hearing date.


