AGREEMENT OF SALE

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 18th day of August, 1980, by and between HAMMEL'S EXPRESS, INC., a corporation, hereinafter referred to as "TRANSFEROR,"

PITT-OHIO EXPRESS, INC., a corporation, hereinafter referred to as "TRANSFEREE,"

WITNESSETH:

- 1. TRANSFER OF RIGHTS. For and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, to be paid in the manner more fully set forth herein, Transferor hereby sells, assigns, and transfers to the Transferee all of its right, title and interest in and to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission certificate at Docket A. 88995, F. 2, Am-E, relating to service for Kinney Service Corp. It is agreed and understood that a copy of the operating rights involved is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.
- 2. <u>RIGHTS INVOLVED</u>. All of the operating rights are being transferred, consisting of the rights at Docket No. A. 88995, F. 2, Am-E. No portion thereof shall be retained by Transferor.
- 3. OTHER PROPERTY. No other property of any kind is involved in this transaction.
- 4. METHOD OF PAYMENT. Payment shall be made within Five (5) days after receipt of a final order from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission approving this transfer.
- 5. COVENANT TO HOLD HARMLESS. Transferor covenants, warrants and guarantees that Transferee shall be held harmless by Transferor from any claims, charges, law suits, judgments, wage claims or debts of any nature whatsoever; and further,

Transferor covenants, warrants and guarantees that any claims, causes of action, liabilities or obligations of Transferor arising out of the operation of the operating rights involved herein prior to the date of consummation of this transaction, shall be the responsibility of Transferor.

- 6. CONTINGENCY OF THIS AGREEMENT. This Agreement shall be contingent upon the approval of the transfer by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and refusal of such approval shall cause this Agreement of Sale to be null and void.
- 7. PARTIAL TRANSFER. It is understood by the parties, and contemplated by them, that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission will transfer all of the operating rights involved intact, and with no diminution or change whatsoever. However, in the event the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission should see fit to alter, change or lessen the rights in any manner, then the Transferee shall have the option of declaring this Agreement null and void.
- 8. <u>BINDING CLAUSE</u>. This Agreement of Sale shall be binding upon the parties, their heirs, executors, or administrators.


