By letter dated August 31, 1983 we transmitted to you by Federal Express the original and two copies of a temporary authority application in behalf of Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc. The application is directly related to a corresponding permanent application at the above docket number which is now unopposed. In order to expedite the processing of the temporary authority application, you kindly permitted us to attach to the application as Supplement to Paragraph 12 a list of the names and addresses of the supporting shippers with the understanding that the original shipper support statements would be delivered to the Commission as soon as possible.

Accordingly, we now deliver to the Commission the original and two copies of the following:

#### 1. Shipper Support Statements.

Supplement to Paragraph 12 of the temporary authority application contains a list of the names and office addresses of 54 supporting shippers. We have been advised that the witnesses for Okonite Company and Yale Industrial Truck (Witness Nos. 35 and 37 on the Supplement to Paragraph 12) are on vacation and in order to expedite the matter,

statements from those witnesses are not included. On the other hand, the name of William T. Delaney, Traffic Manager of H. H. Robertson Co. of Pittsburgh, PA, was inadvertently omitted from the Supplement to Paragraph 12. In addition, the statement of Michael Glumec, Traffic Manager for Kinney Shoe Company (Witness No. 4) has been mailed directly to the Commission. Accordingly, there are attached signed statements from 52 shippers and receivers of freight moving between points in the application territory. An alphabetical index to the supporting statements, which are bound in alphabetical order, is also included.

In that connection, we have been advised by Pitt-Ohio that because of the necessity to expedite the filing of the statements in order to meet the September 16 public meeting date, it was unable to secure all of the supporting statements that otherwise would have been available. The company estimates that given sufficient time, it could produce substantial additional evidence of support for the application. However, it is believed that the enclosed 52 statements are fairly representative and support a grant of general property moving to and from all points in the application territory, as more fully supported by the appendices to the statements.

#### 2. Representative List of Origins and Destinations.

There is attached as Appendix A to the shipper statements an analysis of points of origin and destination in each of the counties involved in the application to and from which the supporting shippers have indicated they have freight moving. A brief review of the summary indicates that the shippers have presented evidence supporting movements to and from all of the major points and most of the smaller points throughout the application territory.

#### 3. Analysis of Commodity Mix.

There is attached as Appendix B to the shipper statements a summary of the commodities which the 53 supporting companies ship and receive between points in the application territory. The list consists of 94 separate commodities which strongly supports applicant's request to transport general property, with the exceptions of commodities in bulk and household goods and office furniture in use.

Heinz USA manufactures and markets approximately 600 varieties and case sizes of canned and preserved foodstuffs. As pertinent to this application, Heinz USA maintains two separate facilities in Allegheny County. A large multiline production facility is maintained in Pittsburgh at 1062 Progress Street, which manufactures baby foods, beans, institutional soups and stews, condiments such as mustard, sauces such as 57 sauce, and private label soups.

A customer service center is maintained at a separate location on West Carson Street some 3 to 5 miles from the plant. This facility maintains a full mix of our product line. Both of these facilities serve points in Beaver, Butler, Crawford, Erie, Fayette, Greene, Lawrence, Mercer, Venango, Warren, Washington and Westmoreland Counties. The annual volume is approximately 962 loads, which moves predominately in truckload quantities.

Heinz USA receives commodities used in manufacturing at our Pittsburgh factory from points within the sought after territory, but the majority of these commodities would move via Heinz private fleet or the vendor will arrange transportation and select the carrier to be used.



Our shipments are primarily truckload but we have approximately 5 inbound and 5 outbound, less than truckload, shipments per week originating or destined to the applicants pending authority. The weight of these shipments is 30,000 +. The list of origins and destination points is attached.

We were recently advised that Breman Express Company has terminated less-than-truckload general freight operations in areas to and from which we have traffic moving.
