

- III Prepare and file a tariff, instructions for which are enclosed.

No motor carrier shall operate or engage in any transportation until all of the above requirements have been complied with and a sertificate of public convenience issued authorizing actual operations. Motor carriers operating without complying with the above requirements will be subject to the penalty provisions of the Public Utility Law.

Commission regulations require compliance with all of the above requirements within thirty days of the date of this letter. Failure to comply within the thirty day period will cause the Commission to rescind the action of and dismiss the application without further proceedings.

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application docketed October 3, 1980, Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, seeks approval of the transfer to it of <u>part</u> of the rights granted to Hammel's Express, Inc., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the certificate issued at A-00088995, Folder 2.

We find the applicant to be fit to hold a certificate of public convenience and that approval of the application is necessary and proper for the continuation of service to the public; THEREFORE,


IT IS ORDERED: That the application for the transfer of part of the rights held by Hammel's Express, Inc., at A-00088995, Folder 2, be approved and that a certificate be issued to the applicant granting the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, such commodities as are dealt in by retail shoe stores, from the distribution facility of Kinney Service Corp., in the township of Hampden, Cumberland County, to points in the counties of Allegheny, Beaver, Butler, Lawrence, Armstrong, Westmoreland, Fayette and Washington;



subject to the following conditions:

1. That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the right to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.



- 2. That applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amount representing the right herein granted, in excess of the actual cost of such right to the original holder thereof.
- 3. That the applicant charge to Account 1550, Other Intangible Property, \$1.00, being the amount of the consideration payable by it for the right and going concern value attributable thereto; less any amount recorded under condition 2 above.
- 4. That the operating authority granted herein, or now held or subsequently granted to the applicant to the extent that it is duplicative shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
- 5. That the certificate holder shall comply with all of the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Pa. Code Title 52, Chapter 31, as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the certificate.
- 6. That the certificate holder shall not transfer, sell or in any way convey any of its outstanding capital stock to any individual, partnership, corporation or any entity, without the prior filing of an application and approval thereof by the Commission under Section 1102(3) of Title 66, PA C.S.A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it has complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of evidence of insurance and a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with this order the right granted the transferor Hammel's Express, Inc., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the Order adopted July 10, 1980 at A-00088995, Folder 2, Am-E, be cancelled.
