Based upon the current instability of the marketplace, Pitt-Ohio will be a stable and reliable source of transportation service for Papercraft now and in the future as we continue to develop and expand our overall operations throughout the territory involved in this proceeding. Other reasons for needing the services for Pitt-Ohio are: The termination of less-than-truckload service by Bremans Express in the Western Pennsylvania area, limited dependable carrier availability and economic considerations.

Papercraft Corporation has utilized the services of applicant for several years in connection with our interstate shipments. We are familiar with applicants good reputation and the responsive service that it provides. We are supporting this application so that applicant can obtain authority to provide us with the same type of service on intrastate shipments as it does on interstate shipments.

Accordingly, we urge the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to approve this application in its entirety.

shipments. Their decision to terminate their LTL operations in the application area has left us without adequate motor carrier service available. This loss of service has created problems for us in meeting our transportation needs.

We have used Pitt-Ohio in the past for our interstate shipments under their ICC authority and they have always provided the quality transportation services which we require, and we feel they are capable of filling the void created by the decline in available service.

For these reasons we are supporting Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc. in their application for permanent authority from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

1. Legal Name and Domicile of Supporting Shipper.

2. Identity and Qualifications of Witness.

My name is George Irvin and I am Traffic Manager for Witco Chemical Corporation. I have been in the employ of this company for 19 years and I have held the position of traffic manager since 1971. My duties include direct responsibility for all transportation arrangements for products manufactured by my company. The information contained herein is based upon my personal knowledge gained through my business activities on behalf of Witco Chemical Corporation. I have been authorized to submit this verified statement in support of the application of Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc. at Docket No. A. 102471, F. 1, Am-B.

3. General Description of Company.

Witco manufactures and packages lubricating and petroleum products at our Bakerstown, PA, facility. They are shipped from this facility Monday through Friday during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

4. Volume and Frequency of Intended Use.

Our company shipments total ten per week, at any estimated weight of 50,000 pounds. All of these shipments are within the scope of the authority sought in this application by Pitt-Ohio Express. We anticipate that they would handle approximately 90% of these shipments for us.

5. Specific or Representative Origins and Destinations.

Attached is a list of origins and destinations which shows that we ship from Allegheny and Venango Counties to points in the Counties of Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Clarion, Crawford, Erie, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Lawrence, Mercer, Venango, Washington and Westmoreland.

6. Type of Service Required.
